Dear Mayor Davy,

I am writing to you today to bring to the Council's attention a current practice by Hopewell Valley Bureau of Fire Safety as it pertains to applications for certification of smoke alarms, carbon monoxide alarm, and fire extinguisher compliance for the sale of private residences in the Borough of Pennington.

Although the Bureau of Fire Safety has resumed commercial and farm inspections at all properties, according to their website, "due to COVID-19 all residential inspections of one and two family dwellings at the time of resale or change of tenancy as required under N.J.A.C.5:70-4,4.19 will be done via Affidavit only. We are NOT conducting in person inspections."

Although our surrounding districts have resumed inspections for residential properties (Raritan, Manalapan, Ewing, Franklin), Hopewell Valley continues to require homeowners to self-certify, while continuing to collect the same fees from the taxpayers of Pennington Borough. What is more alarming is the fact that, "If the home has hardwired smoke alarms or a low voltage alarm system, an inspection report from a licensed electrician or alarm service company is required." They are requiring a homeowner, because they are not performing physical inspections, to HIRE A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN to certify that when the test button on the alarm is pressed, the smoke detectors all function. This local requirement, not required by the Administrative Code, places an undue burden and expense on the backs of our local taxpayers. Quite frankly, I am shocked that this practice has not been brought to your attention sooner.

Item 10.

There are municipalities, such as Egg Harbor Township, that require self-certification. However, there is no requirement homeowner to hire a licensed electrician.

Please find attached the documents referenced in this letter and I hope that the Borough Council can assist our local homeowners, seniors who are looking to downsize after paying decades of high taxes as well as many families that move WITHIN our cherished Borough, in ending this current practice.

I plan on attending the Borough Council meeting on July 5th, and can address this issue in more detail if requested.

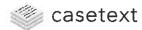

Section 5:70-4.19 - Smoke alarms for one- and two-family dwellings; carbon monoxide alarms; and portable fire extinguishers

- (a) In one- and two-family or attached single family dwellings subject to the requirements of 5:70-2.3, smoke alarms shall be installed as follows:
 - 1. On each level of the premises; and
 - 2. Outside of each separate sleeping area.
- (b) The smoke alarms required in (a) above shall be located and maintained in accordance with NFPA 72.
 - 1. The alarms shall not be required to be interconnected.
- (c) Ten-year sealed battery-powered single station smoke alarms shall be installed and shall be listed in accordance with ANSI/UL 217, incorporated herein by reference. However, A/C-powered single or multiple-station smoke alarms installed as part of the original construction or rehabilitation project shall not be replaced with battery-powered smoke alarms. The effective date of this subsection shall be January 1, 2019.

two-family or attached single family dwellings, except for units in buildings that do not contain a fuel-burning device or have an attached garage, as follows:

- 1. Single station carbon monoxide alarms shall be installed and maintained in the immediate vicinity of the sleeping area(s).
- **2.** Carbon monoxide alarms may be battery-operated, hard-wired or of the plug-in type and shall be listed and labeled in accordance with UL-2034 and shall be installed in accordance with the requirements of this section and NFPA-720.
- (e) A portable fire extinguisher shall be installed in accordance with the following:
 - 1. The extinguisher shall be within 10 feet of the kitchen and located in the path of egress;
 - 2. The extinguisher shall be readily accessible and not obstructed from view;
 - The extinguisher shall be mounted using the manufacturer's hanging bracket so the operating instructions are clearly visible;
 - 4. The extinguisher shall be an approved listed and labeled type with a minimum rating of 2A-10B:C and no more than 10 pounds;
 - 5. The owner's manual or written operation instructions shall be provided during the inspection and left for the new occupant;
 - **6.** The extinguisher shall be serviced and tagged by a certified Division of Fire Safety contractor within the past 12 months or the seller must have a receipt for a recently purchased extinguisher; and
 - 7. The top of the extinguisher shall not be more than five feet above the floor.
 - **8.** Exception: Portable fire extinguishers shall not be required for seasonal summer units. For purposes of applying this exception, "seasonal summer unit" shall mean a dwelling unit rented for a term of not more than 125 consecutive days for residential purposes by a person having a permanent residence elsewhere, but shall not include use or rental of living quarters by migrant, temporary, or seasonal workers in connection with any work or place where work is being performed.

- Picture of mounted fire extinguisher and receipt for new purchase or current inspection tag
- If the home has hardwired smoke alarms or a low voltage alarm system, an inspection report from a licensed electrician or alarm service company is required.
- A picture of the mounted carbon monoxide alarm

It is recommended that the seller establish and escrow account with a minimum of \$300 in case the buyer moves in and claims something is not correct with the smoke alarms, carbon monoxide alarm or portable fire extinguisher.



Example of fire extinguisher for illustration purposes only. No specific brand is required or recommended. The extinguisher shall comply with:

- N.J.A.C.5:70-4.19(e) A portable fire extinguisher shall be installed in accordance with the following:
- 1. The extinguisher shall be within 10 feet of the kitchen and located in the path of egress;
- 2. The extinguisher shall be readily accessible and not obstructed from view;
- 3. The extinguisher shall be mounted using the manufacturer's hanging bracket so the operating instructions are clearly visible;
- 4. The extinguisher shall be an approved listed and labeled type with a minimum ration of 2A-10B:C and no more than 10 pounds;
- 5. The owner's manual or written operation instructions shall be provided during the inspection and left for the new occupant;
- 6. The extinguisher shall be serviced and tagged by a certified Division of Fire Safety contractor within the past 12 months or the seller must have a receipt for a recently purchased extinguisher; and
- 7. The top of the extinguisher shall not be more than five feet above the floor.

WHEREAS, Borough Council seeks to continue its program of deer management designed to control the population of deer in Pennington Borough by entering into a contract with professional deer hunter Brian Kubin, doing business in Hopewell Township as Scorpion Outdoors Deer Management (hereafter "Scorpion Outdoors");

WHEREAS, attached to this Resolution are copies of the Proposal by Scorpion Outdoors presented to Pennington in June 2020 describing their methodology and terms of engagement (16 pages);

WHEREAS, services will include a pre-season site survey to designate hunting locations, the establishment of bait stations, camera monitoring, hunting sessions, deer harvest, deer removal and deer donation, among a range of additional activities as described in the attached Proposal;

WHEREAS, the Proposal includes background information on Mr. Kubin which is supplemented in additional information also attached to this Resolution;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the attached terms proposed by Mr. Kubin with respect to fees and reimbursable costs for 2022-23, Scorpion Outdoors will charge for its services as follows: (1) \$165 for each deer harvested, which will cover all activities leading up to the deer harvest, such that unless deer are harvested, there will be no charge for these activities; (2) the cost of corn bait up to \$14 to \$16 per bag, with a minimum of two bags of bait per hunt per season; and (3) in the event donations of harvested deer cannot be accomplished without charge, a charge of \$90 for processing the deer through Hunters Helping the Hungry;

WHEREAS, Scorpion Outdoors will be responsible for all record keeping of harvested deer in compliance with State law and will submit monthly invoices to the Borough;

WHEREAS, Mr. Kubin represents that he and Scorpion Outdoors possess all necessary licenses for the activity they propose, he will provide copies of these licenses to the Borough so that they may be kept on file, and he will keep all such licenses in effect for the duration of the contract with the Borough;

WHEREAS, Mr. Kubin and Scorpion Outdoors will supply the Borough with proof of liability insurance with coverage limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate, naming the Borough of Pennington as an additional insured;

WHEREAS, Scorpion Outdoors will indemnify and hold harmless the Borough of Pennington for damage to person or property in connection with its contracted activities;
