Issues raised may be referred to Town Staff for research and possible future action.

Gene Bostick reported to the Council that he had submitted a petition for release to the Town Staff and told them that they would either release his property or provide him with water. Sheri Clearman, Town Secretary stated that he did submit a petition and that an ordinance to update the official ETJ Map would be heard at the November 2023 Town Council Meeting.

Jared Thomas showed the Town Council rendering photos of the outside of his future restaurant that included a privacy fence and a mural. He stated that he wanted to open his business in October. Mr. Thomas also stated that he wants to say in Ponder and do business here also. He said that many other Towns have offered him a spot for his restaurant but that he refuses because he loves Ponder. Mr.

Thomas told the Council that he was sure that they have already seen on Facebook all that he does for this Town. He asked that the Town Council do everything they can to expedite the process.

Sue Partridge asked how much revenue the water rate increase would bring in annually. Gary Morris replied \$80,000.

Craig Kinney reported to the Council that there was a zoning discrepancy between the Town of Ponder and Denton County. Sheri Clearman, Town Secretary explained that the Town is the zoning authority for anything within the corporate limits and that the County has nothing to do with it.
