A ORDINANCE CALLING A GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS, PLACE TWO, PLACE FOUR AND MAYOR, ESTABLISHING THE DATES AND TIMES OF EARLY VOTING FOR SUCH ELECTION; AND ESTABLISHING A DATE FOR A RUNOFF ELECTION, IF REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Election Code of the State of Texas and the Local Government Code §22.033 three shall be held in each municipality in the State of Texas, a general election for the purpose of electing officials of said municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Election Code provides that the governing body of a municipality shall be the authority to order a General Election for the City Officers; and

WHEREAS, Election Code provides that a municipal election shall be ordered not later than the 71st day before Election Day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PONDER, TEXAS:

Section 1

The Town Council for the Town of Ponder, Texas at a regular meeting held this date, does hereby order an election of officers for the Town of Ponder, Texas, to be held on the second Saturday in May, that being May 1, 2021, for the purpose of electing Town Council Members for Place two, Place four and Mayor who shall serve for a period of two years or until their successors have been duly qualified. The candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast for Council Member for Place Two, the candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast for Place Four and the candidate receiving a majority of the votes for Mayor shall be declared elected to such offices.

Section 2

All qualified voters determined by the laws of the State of Texas shall be qualified to vote at such election. For the purpose of said election, the entire Town is hereby constituted into one voting precinct. Voting on Election Day, May 1, 2021, shall be conducted at the Ponder Town Hall located at 102 W. Bailey Street, Ponder, Texas and said election shall be held between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on the aforementioned date.

Section 3

Applications for candidacy to the offices of Council Member for Place Two and Place Four and Mayor shall be made to the Town Secretary for the Town of Ponder beginning at 7:30 a.m., January 12, 2021 and not later than 11:30 a.m. on February 13, 2021, in manner and form as prescribed by law.

Section 4

The names of eligible and qualified candidates for such office shall be placed on the ballots for such election by the Town Secretary at the time and manner prescribed by law.

Section 5

Early voting for the above designated election shall be conducted at the main early voting location, Denton County Elections, 701 Kimberly Drive, Denton, TX 76208, and other locations will be available as per the joint contract with Denton County. The early voting clerk for said election shall be Frank Phillips, Denton County Elections Administrator and applications for a ballot to be voted by mail shall be addressed to him.

Section 6

The results of the election shall be certified, canvassed and returned in form and manner prescribed by the laws of the State of Texas.

Section 7

The notice of the election hereby ordered and called shall be promulgated, published and posted in keeping with the laws of the State of Texas.

Section 8

Any runoff election required for the election of the Members of the Town Council or Mayor for the Town of Ponder, Texas following the regular election of May 1, 2021 shall be held on a date specified in the joint election contract with Denton County.

ORDINANCE 21-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PONDER, TEXAS AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF PONDER, **CHAPTER 154, SECTION 154.38 OFF STREET PARKING;** PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Ponder, Texas (the "Town"), is a Type A General Law municipality having powers of self-government and may enact ordinances relative to its citizens' health, safety, and welfare that are not inconsistent with the Constitution and laws of the State; and

WHEREAS, Section 601.001 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a municipality by ordinance may regulate the parking of motor vehicles on private property and may enforce the ordinance in the same manner that it enforces ordinances regulating parking in public no-parking zones; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to implement rules and regulations that protect health, life, and property and that preserve good government, order, and security of the Town and its inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the Town has determined that it is a necessity to regulate activities as provided for herein to safeguard the public and protect health, life, and property; and

WHEREAS, the Town is authorized by law to adopt the provisions contained herein, and has complied with all the prerequisites necessary for the passage of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, all statutory and constitutional requirements for the passage of this ordinance have been adhered to, including, but not limited to the Open Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the Town of Ponder, Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Ponder, Texas:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That, the statements contained in the preamble to this ordinance are hereby adopted as findings of fact and as a part of the operative provisions hereof.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That, the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Ponder, **CHAPTER 154 SECTION 154.38 OFF STREET PARKING** is amended to add the following:

1. Definitions:

- a. "Vehicle" has the same meaning as the definition in Section 502.001(45) of the Texas Transportation Code, as amended.
- b. "Trailer" has the same meaning as the definition in Section 502.001(42) of the Texas Transportation Code, as amended.

- c. "Distinguishable border" means permanent curbing of concrete, wood, brick, or stone that forms a perimeter at least a foot away from any vehicle or trailer that is parked within said curbing.
- d. "Improved driveway" means a surface made of concrete or asphalt in a front yard.
- e. "Parking surface" or "PAD" means a surface that is constructed of concrete, asphalt, paving stones, brick, gravel, or crushed rock with a distinguishable border. PADs shall not be located in front yards or side yards of districts zoned single family or two family. PADs shall not be located in front yards of districts zoned multifamily.

2. <u>Prohibited Off Street Parking</u>.

- a. Vehicles and trailers shall not be parked in the front yard or side yard of any lot in a district zoned single family or two family that is less than one half (1/2) acre.
- b. Vehicles and trailers shall not be parked in the front yard of any lot in a district zoned multifamily.
- c. Vehicles and trailers in the back yard of any lot in a district zoned single family or two family that is less than one half (1/2) acre must be parked on a PAD with a distinguishable border.
- d. Vehicles and trailers in the back yard or side yard of any lot in a district zoned multifamily must be parked on a PAD with a distinguishable border.
- e. Vehicles and trailers shall be maintained so as not to endanger the public health and safety.
- f. Parked vehicles or trailers longer than 19 feet, excluding the length of a trailer hitch or goose neck, shall have wheel blocks in front of and behind at least one set of wheels on said vehicle or trailer.
- g. Junked Motor Vehicles. See Sections 92.30 to 92.38 of the Code of Ponder.
- h. Vehicles and trailers shall not be parked on unimproved lots in districts zoned single family, two family, or multifamily.

3. Defenses.

- a. It shall be a defense to prosecution that a vehicle or trailer was parked on an unimproved lot while there was a valid building permit for said lot and the owner of said vehicle or trailer owned said lot or was under contract to improve said lot.
- b. It shall be an affirmative defense to prosecution that a vehicle or trailer was parked in districts zoned as HO (Historic Overlay District).

4. Defenses excluded.

- a. It shall not be a defense to prosecution that a vehicle or trailer was intended for use as or used as a dwelling for human beings or animals, regardless of whether or not said vehicle or trailer was fit for human or animal habitation.
- b. It shall not be a defense to prosecution that a lot had no front, side, or back yard because the lot was unimproved.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> That, all ordinances or any parts thereof in conflict with the terms of this ordinance shall be and hereby are deemed repealed and of no force or effect.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That, any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$500.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> That, should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part thereof decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, and the same shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Ponder as a whole.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> That, this ordinance shall take effect immediately following its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.

On November 9, 2020, the Town Council conditionally approved a Preliminary Plat for Lot 1 Block 1 Christian Faith Fellowship Addition consistent with the Town Engineer's recommendation of November 4, 2020. The applicant has since submitted a Final Plat and Site Plan for the referenced development. This letter provides review comments of the submittal which includes a Final Plat [no date] by Castlerock Surveying, PLLC, Justin, Texas, with supporting Site Plan and Final Engineering dated December 4, 2020 by Spiars Engineering, Plano, Texas, representing Applicant Darryl Baker, Christian Faith Fellowship, Ponder, Texas. The submittal also includes a Landscape Plan (dated November 2020) by Cooper Design Works of Rockwall, Texas.

<u>Location</u> – south side of FM 2449 approx. ½ mile west of FM 156, within Ponder Corporate Limits (City)

Comprehensive Plan - Proposed Use - Church

Submittal Analysis

The purpose of this Final Plat is to create a lot of record for the proposed construction of a Church facility. No other uses are proposed. The Final Plat and supporting documents are reasonably consistent with the conditionally approved Preliminary Plat and its supporting documents.

The site is currently zoned Agricultural which will require the applicant to request a Specific Use Permit from the Town prior to construction. This hearing can be concurrent with the Town's consideration of a Site Plan. Alternatively, the applicant may request rezoning to C-1 or C-2 for right of use.

Current data indicates that the Town should have adequate water supply capacity sufficient to serve the proposed development subject to the completion of a 12" water line adjacent to FM 2449 (now under construction by the Town.) To facilitate system looping and fire protection, the development proposes to extend an 8" waterline along the east side of the tract. The Town's Water Master Plan recommends this line as a 12" that would suggest that the Town participate in oversizing the extension.

Ongoing improvements to the treatment plant should provide necessary capacity to service the proposed development; however, no sewer system exists in the immediate area. The applicant proposes to install a system extension (adjacent to and offsite) to connect to a proposed line now under construction within the Clairmont Addition. The developer will be eligible for potential (partial) reimbursement for the offsite section under current Town policies.

Storm water runoff from the proposed development is to be collected at the south side of the development in a proposed detention pond with controlled pre-development storm water discharged into a roadway ditch at the southeast corner of the development now under construction by the Town.

Access to the site is proposed via a single drive to FM 2449 and by two drives to Park Road (now under-construction by the Town) adjacent to the east side of the property. Access to FM 2449 is subject to TxDOT approval, which requires Town concurrence. Additional study may be required by TxDOT as a part of the permitting process, which may also require turn lane(s) at this drive or Park Road.

Park Road however, is being constructed by the Town as a gravel road and will be not sufficient to manage the expected weekly traffic loading caused by the development. It is recommended that the development participate with the Town in upgrading the roadway to concrete to a section more consistent with Town standards.

An ongoing TxDOT FM 2449 Feasibility Study does not suggest that this development accommodate future ROW expansion to the south of the current limits. No additional ROW appears to be necessary for proposed Park Road.

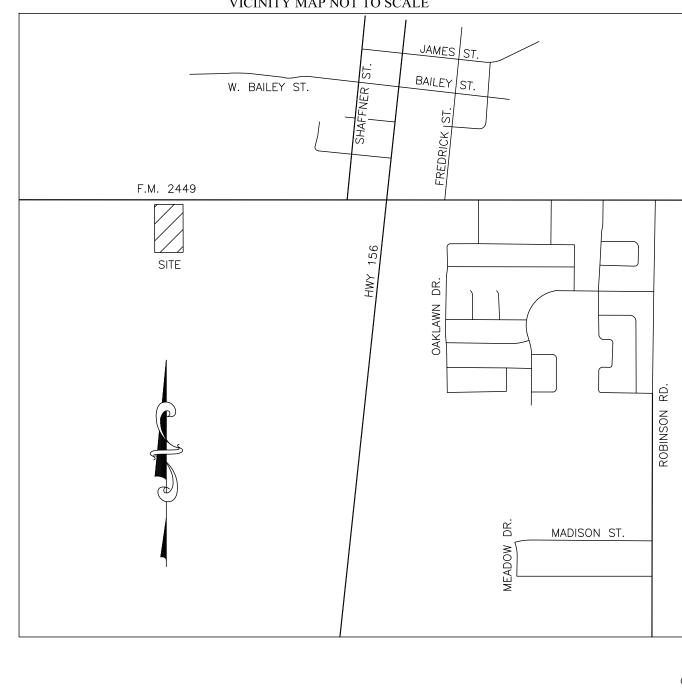
