Councilor Jungmann made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion seconded. No discussion on motion. All in favor, motion carried.

#### **Council Business**

3. CC Health Department Update

September 22, 2020 Page 2 of 5

Vicky Ryan, Crook County Public Information Officer provided an update that included: having 60 cases with 32 active; doing some things right since we have only had one new case as of today; Deschutes County numbers are up; there will be a drive up flu clinic that will be available to all city and county; they will have a drive through for potential COVID vaccinations; CDC has recommended no trick or treating as well as upcoming holiday gatherings.

Discussions continued regarding the school district; grades K-3 being secure at this time, grades 4-12 will be evaluated in October to see if we met matrix; and movement on the pilot program proposed to the Governor for small schools.

Ms. Ryan explained about the close contact criteria and having a higher probability of becoming positive by being around someone positive while awaiting the test results. If they come back negative they are removed from list. They are finding that those tested are being very cooperative and can have a contact circle up to 30 so far.

#### 4. Consideration of the Sale of Real Property – Eric Klann

Jered Reid, City Attorney provided the background information explaining this was discussed in Executive Session and if Council decided to move forward there would be a public hearing scheduled between October 5-9<sup>th</sup>.

No questions from council.

Councilor Papke made a motion that it is convenient for the City of Prineville to sell 21.13 acres of real property identified as Tax Lot 141600-1600 and that a public hearing be scheduled and appropriately noticed. Motion seconded. No discussion on motion. All in favor, motion carried.

# **5. Approval of Draft Council Letter to Ochoco National Forest** – Councilors Hutchison and Rumble

Councilor Hutchison provided background and wanted to highlight a couple of items in the letter such as the 21" rule, science, economy, monitoring, and reporting of whether it has met desired results.

Councilor Rumble talked about different options and that Option 2 is more of the forest service choice and there is a high probability it will go to litigation. Councilor Rumble feels the city needs to jump behind by submitting comments to get the forest cleaned up and recommended we add language that the entire council supports unanimously.

Councilor Papke appreciates the long term work on this and supports whatever will have the greatest input for council.

Councilor Beebe agrees with Councilor Rumble.

Councilor Rumble talked more about the wasted resources and moonscapes and it all has to do with forest management.

Councilor Merritt agrees with everything said in the letter.

Councilor Jungmann said letter was beautiful and agrees we need to get our forest cleaned up.

Councilor Rumble asked about changing the last paragraph to city council voted unanimously on such a date and she would support putting that language.

Councilor Rumble made motion to approve Council comment letter to Ochoco National Forest with amendment as discussed. Motion seconded. Discussion on motion regarding deadline of 10/13 to submit the letter. We can get it in tomorrow. Getting letter in sooner will help others wordsmith their letters. White fir over 21" in close proximity to ponderosa pine. Removal of the white fir and other species due to disease and infestations applying common sense to remove will allow other species to be removed with common sense. All in favor motion carried.

#### **Staff Reports and Requests:**

#### 6. Manager's Report

Steve Forrester, City Manager reported: there will be professional training covering breaking away from bias on the 16<sup>th</sup> along with the JEDI committee, Liz Schuette, Finance Director and accounting staff has finished reviewing refunding DEQ debt along with the covenants of that loan, and it does not justify refunding at this time; Public Works is repairing Harwood Bridge footing due to previous high water; the Police Department facility tour went well and the building is well underway.

There were no questions.

#### 7. EDCO COVID Grant Update – Kelsey Lucas

Ms. Lucas provided an update that highlighted sending out last 4 award letters in phase 3; over 82 % of applicants were awarded up to \$2,500; 118 businesses were awarded; business demographics; a total of \$272,845 was awarded; different industries affected; owner versus renter demographics; and reduced staff and hours.

Discussions continued regarding how impressive it was that everyone adapted through this; and how most of the businesses closed were actually planning on closing within a couple of years anyway.

Mr. Forrester thanked Facebook, the Chamber, EDCO and everyone else that helped with this effort.

#### **Committee Reports**

Councilor Jungmann provided a NeighborImpact update. They have been very busy and are opening up more childcare openings; hiring new staff and increasing meals; providing rental assistance which has seen an increase in central Oregon; 85% of renters out there are receiving help already; mortgage assistance is available; food banks that usually get one semi-truck of food a week prior to COVID and are now doing 5 semi-trucks a week; and the empty bowls fundraiser will be virtual this year.

Councilor Papke talked about the Crooked River Roundup joining the Central Oregon rodeo this last week, and thanked those involved. Councilor Papke also thanked the county for promoting the potato harvest and this year will donate to state and first responders. Volunteers are needed at 8 am on Barnes Butte Road to bag up the potatoes to take to the valley.

Mayor Uffelman announced he was approached to serve on Regional Recovery Task Force which will go on for about the next year.

#### **Council Business**

1. Consideration to Sell Real Property (PUBLIC HEARING)

Mayor Uffelman read the public hearing procedure into the record.

Mike Warren Jr., Realtor of Record provided his assessment report highlighting how the value of property is determined and how it is based on the number of lots that could be created.

Mr. Warren, determined that the offer is very fair when comparable to other similar property and that the city is in good shape with the price offered.

No questions or comments from Council.

Eric Klann, City Engineer provided a power point presentation explaining that the original purpose for the city to purchase was water rights, ability to extend Combs Flat Road to Peters Road and open space.

Mr. Klann continued by stating the design of Combs Flat Road extension under way. Echo of the Butte Concept Plan for Barnes Butte Recreation area is pretty much completed and went over highlights of the proposed plan. A local developer is interested in property and provided a map of proposed layout. The estimated grand total of \$1.3 million is what the city could sell for. Mr. Klann went over a summary slide showing after the sale, we would keep 600 open space, 305 acres of water rights. We purchased in 2017 for 1.2 million and selling 21 acres for 1.3 million.

No questions or concerns from council.

#### Mayor opened the public hearing portion of the meeting.

Mark Haskell via telephonically has a question about potential buyer and stated he is a Hillsboro resident.

Mayor Uffelman explained to Mr. Haskell that he is not eligible to make a public hearing comment per ORS.

Jered Reid, City Attorney clarified that the meeting is open to view, and that testimony is limited to Prineville residents.

2. Resolution No. 1459 – Authorizing a Loan from the Special Works Fund by Entering Into a Financing Contract with the Oregon Infrastructure Finance Authority – Eric Klann

Mr. Klann provided a power point presentation that highlighted the Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) Budget and the purpose of this resolution is for a loan. The System Development Charges (SDC's) covered the original estimated costs. Mr. Klann explained that the project is a progressive design build and the differences between this method and a design bid build. The reason for the increase from original estimate is due to construction costs increasing, scope gaps, additional treatment needed for this water and some frustrating geology.

This loan will be refunded by future SDC's and this is a generational project that will be paid off as the city grows.

There were no questions or comments from Council.

Mayor Uffelman added that this project will be very significant to the city in the long term to allow for future development and very environmentally conscientious.

Councilor Merritt made motion to approve Resolution No. 1459. Motion seconded. No discussion on motion. All in favor motion carried.

Mr. Klann thanked Council for the vote and added this is the type of support that allows us to attract new businesses.


