1. Call to Order / Roll Call.

2. Consider and act upon the minutes of the May 13, 2026, Parks and Recreation Board Meeting.

The motion to approve the minutes was made by Board Member Horan, seconded by Secretary Castro. The motion was carried unanimously by a vote of 5-0.

4. Receive staff updates: Recreation, Park Development, Park Operations, and Director.

Recreation Manager Trevor Helton shared recreation updates on the Mayor's Fitness Challenge 250 Strong and Pickleball courts.

Parks Planning Manager Randy Breeding presented on park development updates:

Raymond Community Park:

The sod installation across the entire site is 94% complete. General clean-up activities are ongoing across the site. The playground is 100% complete and open to the public. Concession building detail items are in progress. The well construction is 80% complete, and pump construction is underway. The contractor is working to complete punch-list.

Parvin Park:

Project Scope: Loop Trail, Small Playground, Small Pavilion, Picnic Tables, Drinking Fountain, Parking Spaces.

Construction began on March 13, 2026, and will last until Fall of 2026. Concrete placement is 90%, and fine grading is currently in progress.

Parks Superintendent Matt Furr presented park operations updates. Site grading and base preparation activities are underway near the ballfield at Frontier Park. Contractors are compacting the subgrade and establishing proper elevations in preparation for turf installation. An update was also provided regarding concerns at Frontier Park related to concrete cracking and walkway grade issues.

Director David Angeles provided a brief overview of the communication process for public inquiries received by Parks and Recreation Board members. He also noted that the Parks and Recreation Board Work Session would begin immediately following the meeting at 6:35 p.m. Additionally, he stated that the next regular Parks and Recreation Board meeting is scheduled for July 9, though it may be rescheduled or canceled, as has been done historically due to summer scheduling.

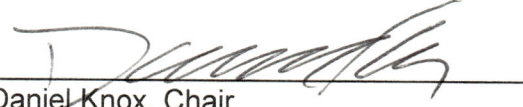

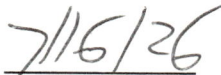
