**CALL TO ORDER:** Chair Fruit called the meeting to order at 5:04PM.

Present: Susan Fruit, Kevin Melby. Absent: Scotty Wallace – *excused*. A quorum was present. Oliphant affirmed proper public notice.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Motion to approve the meeting minutes of the 3/30/2023 Property Committee meeting. Motion made by Melby, Seconded by Fruit. Voting Yea: Fruit, Melby. Motion carried.

**APPROVAL OF BILLS:** Motion to approve Property bills for payment. Motion made by Melby, Seconded by Fruit. Voting Yea: Fruit, Melby. Motion Carried.

#### **DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS**

City Hall Carpet Replacement: Superintendent Fry explained the carpet in the Municipal Building was original except for in the Clerk/Treasurer's Office and part of the Police Department. Of the remaining original carpet, significant wear is visible necessitating replacement. To determine the anticipated cost, a local vendor was contacted to obtain a replacement quote. The quote received for the replacement and installation of carpet tile was \$17, 519.46. Fry was instructed to report back once he had obtained a quote from another local vendor.

Purchase of New Buildings & Grounds 2023 Silverado 2500HD Regular Cab 4WD: Superintendent Fry requested consideration for the purchase of 2023 Chevrolet Silverado ¾ ton single cab with dump box and plow as his previous order could not be fulfilled. Upon purchase, Fry to sell the department's 2007 ½ ton and plow for an estimated \$8,000. The department will then operate with four trucks rather than five. The price of the 2023 Chevy Silverado with dump box and snow plow was \$62,500. Fry was previously authorized to spend up to \$58,200 for the purchase of a truck. Fry advised the savings from the purchase of weed eaters was more than sufficient to cover the difference.

Motion to recommend to the Finance Committee to authorize the purchase of a 2023 Chevrolet Silverado ¾ ton truck with dump box and plow from Holz. Motion made by Melby, Seconded by Fruit. Voting Yea: Fruit, Melby, Motion Carried.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:** Superintendent Fry provided updates on the receipt of weed eaters, installation of dike lights, water status at the parks, workload demand at the cemetery, and department preparation for the summer.
