4. Farmers Market Updates (Amy/Amber)  
Amy McKernan and Amber Chitwood were present to give an update on the market. The first outdoor market starts May 1st. The market expects approximately 50 vendors this year, plus food and coffee trucks and live music. Cullen gave an update on park bathrooms. Bathrooms will open once the sign of frost has passed and all updates are complete.

## 1: Youth baseball

Johnson gave an update on youth baseball. Six kids signed up for tee ball and three kids between coach pitch, 3-4 grade and 5-6 baseball signed up. The commission decided that there will not be enough kids for coach pitch and the 3-6 grade baseball teams, but tee ball can proceed. Rock Reeson was present and said he will work with the other volunteer coaches to figure out practice times for tee ball. The village office will update the parents of the kids who signed up.

## 2: Home Talent

Casper gave an update on Home Talent. Thursday night league games are scheduled for June 2,16,23 and July 28. Sunday exhibition games are to be determined.

### 6. Internship Update (Maggie)

Johnson gave an update on the Park and Recreation position. The position is still open and applicants are welcomed to apply.

### 7. Concession Stand Plan (Michele)

Casper discussed the current plan for the concession stand. A signup will be posted online for those interested.

### 8. Dog Park Update (Maggie/Hailey)

Johnson presented quotes for the dog tag fundraiser. The commission suggested looking into further options. M Johnson also mentioned the village office will be applying for the DNR Stewardship grant for the village park and dog park funding.

### 9. Community Outdoor Movie (Maggie/Megan)

Johnson presented details on the outdoor community movie. The first outdoor movie will be at the community center on April 23rd and will start at 8pm. Due to the licensing requirements, movie details will be posted on the village website.
