D. Executive Session

The Town Council may vote to go into executive session pursuant to M.G.L. ch. 30A, section 21(a)(3) relative to potential litigation strategy concerning re-precincting and re-districting as well as negotiations with the Tri-Board. M.G.L. ch. 30A, section 21(a)(3) permits a public body to go into executive session to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining or litigation if an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the public body and the chair so declares.

1. The Subcommittee may vote to go into executive session pursuant to M.G.L. ch. 30A, section 21(a)(2) for the purpose of preparing for contract negotiations or for conducting contract negotiations with the Town Finance Director/Town Accountant. Under the Open Meeting Law, a public body may go into executive session to conduct strategy sessions in preparation for negotiations with nonunion personnel or to conduct collective bargaining sessions or contract negotiations with nonunion personnel.
