

#### CALL ROLLINGWOOD COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION MEETING TO ORDER

1. Roll Call

President Emily Doran called the meeting to order at 5:37 p.m.

2. Discussion and possible action on the minutes from the December 18, 2023 RCDC meeting

3. Update from the Retail Coach

President Emily Doran discussed a report from the Retail Coach including representing Rollingwood at the ICSC Red River Conference, Rollingwood Plaza, Park Hills Baptist Church, and the Rollingwood Commercial Exchange Meeting.

The RCDC discussed the Rollingwood Commercial Exchange meeting times and dates.

Brian Rider moved to authorize \$1,000 for the purpose of this gathering max. Bobby Hempfling seconded the motion. The motion carried with 4 in favor and 0 against.

The RCDC determined which developers would be able to attend and planned the date for the first week in March or alternatively the week of March 18<sup>th</sup> at lunchtime.

Brian Rider and the RCDC discussed the incentive policy options for all Economic Development Corporations.

David Smith joined the meeting at 5:51 p.m.

The RCDC discussed the site of the church including homes that back up to it, the flood plain, the school, MoPac, TXDoT right of way, and retail incentive options.

4. Discussion and possible action on a resolution setting the date and time of regular Rollingwood Community Development Corporation meetings and setting the annual meeting for the election of officers

Barry Delcambre moved to approve Resolution 2024-02-12-04 in the packet. Bobby Hempfling seconded the motion. The motion carried with 5 in favor and 0 against.

Update on City Council action regarding budget amendment for future park projects and RCDC funding for a park retaining wall

Assistant City Administrator Desiree Adair reported that City Council has reappointed all members that were up for reappointment in the RCDC, approved the budget amendment for future park projects of \$50,000, and approved RCDC funding for the Park retaining wall not to exceed \$31,000. She stated that there would be \$19,000 remaining for Park projects to be funded by RCDC this fiscal year.

Bobby Hempfling will reach out to Melissa Morrow, the Chair of the Park Commission, for coordination with Park projects.

6. Discussion and possible action to elect a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Rollingwood Community Development Corporation

Brian Rider moved Bobby Hempfling as Treasurer of RCDC. David Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried with 5 in favor and 0 against.

The RCDC discussed the March meeting time and decided to have the next meeting on Monday, March 4th at 5:30 p.m.
