BACKGROUND

The City of Salida Tree Board is governed under Chapter 2, Article 12, of the Municipal Code. The code identifies that it is the responsibility of the Tree Board to develop and/or update a proposed work plan including recommended practices associated with the care, preservation, trimming, planting, replanting, removal, or disposition of street and park trees.

The Tree Board shall consist of a minimum of three members. Currently the Tree Board has two active members and staff is recommending a total of five members. Ordinance 2022-04 identified that all members shall be residents of Chaffee County and no more than two (2) members may reside outside of the City.

Staff recommends that Council conduct an application review and interview of the applicants.

Salida RV Resort update and presentation with Owner, Brian Morrison

BACKGROUND

City Council directed staff at the last Council meeting to work on identifying a location(s) where local workforce who are living in their vehicles can safely park overnight and remain during the day, if they so choose. This concept originated with Bringing Everyone Through the Crisis of Housing (BETCH) organization. Previously, staff had recommended a overnight parking location (by permit only) of the Touber Building; however, due to the amount of use of that lot by both City and County staff, as well as members of the public doing business within the building, overnight vehicles would need to vacate the premises by 7:30AM. This was viewed as a challenge to those individuals, some of whom work into the late hours and because they would still need to find other locations to park during the day where they would not be forced to move frequently or risk being cited.

Staff has assessed several potential locations for a "Safe Outdoor Space"/overnight workforce parking permit program, based upon several markers, including: ample space, proximity to downtown, accessibility, availability of water, shade protection, public parking opportunities, and safety, among others. We will present our preferred location, along with the framework for an agreement with BETCH (or other qualified organization) to administer/oversee the program from approximately May through October. City Council's feedback and direction is appreciated.








Most Serious Problem Facing the City of Salida Today

And among the following options, what would you consider to be the most serious problem facing Salida today?







What level of resources do you want the City to allocate to the following?


Among All Respondents – Ranked by % "More Than Right Now"



Among the following options, which one should be the main economic development focus of the City?

























What are your two primary modes of transportation? (Pick two)





What level of resources do you want the City of Salida to allocate to the following in order to improve the Salida Transportation System?



















Safe Outdoor Space/Overnight Parking Permit Program for Spring/Summer/Fall 2022

BACKGROUND

City Council directed staff at the last Council meeting to work on identifying a location(s) where local workforce who are living in their vehicles can safely park overnight and remain during the day, if they so choose. This concept originated with Bringing Everyone Through the Crisis of Housing (BETCH) organization. Previously, staff had recommended a overnight parking location (by permit only) of the Touber Building; however, due to the amount of use of that lot by both City and County staff, as well as members of the public doing business within the building, overnight vehicles would need to vacate the premises by 7:30AM. This was viewed as a challenge to those individuals, some of whom work into the late hours and because they would still need to find other locations to park during the day where they would not be forced to move frequently or risk being cited.

Staff has assessed several potential locations for a "Safe Outdoor Space"/overnight workforce parking permit program, based upon several markers, including: ample space, proximity to downtown, accessibility, availability of water, shade protection, public parking opportunities, and safety, among others. We will present our preferred location, along with the framework for an agreement with BETCH (or other qualified organization) to administer/oversee the program from approximately May through October. City Council's feedback and direction is appreciated.
