ORDINANCE 2024-16

ORDINANCE ABATING THE TAX HERETOFORE LEVIED FOR 2024 TO PAY THE DEBT SERVICE ON A PORTION (NOT TO EXCEED) OF \$3,500,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS (ALTERNATE REVENUE SOURCE) OF THE CITY OF SANDWICH, DEKALB AND KENDALL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2020-19, AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSURANCE NOT TO EXCEED \$3,500,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS (ALTETERNATE REVENUE SOURCE), SERIES 2021, OF THE CITY OF SANDWICH, DEKALB AND KENDALL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, PROVIDING THE DETAILS OF SUCH BONDS AND FOR APPLICABLE ALTERNATE REVENUE SOURCE AND THE LEVY OF DIRECT ANNUAL TAXES SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS, AND RELATED MATTERS, adopted by the City Council of the City of Sandwich, DeKalb and Kendall Counties, Illinois (the "Issuer") on December 21, 2020 (as supplemented by a CERTIFICATE OF ABATEMENT AND REDUCTION OF TAXES HERETOFORE LEVIED FOR THE PAYMENT OF BONDS), the City Council of the City of Sandwich, hereby determines that it is appropriate to reduce by abatement the tax levy for 2024 (to be received in 2025) as provided in Section 10 of Ordinance No. 2020-19; and

WHEREAS, the City will have sufficient funds including investment earnings, to pay the principal and interest on the Bonds on the payment dates; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City that the taxes heretofore levied for the year 2021 to pay the debt service on the Bonds be abated; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Sandwich, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Abatement of Tax. The County Clerks of DeKalb and Kendall Counties are hereby directed to abate taxes for the above described Bond Issue provided for in Ordinance No. 2020-19 as herein set forth and to be levied in 2024, as shown:

Otherwise Ordinance No. 2020-19 and the Certificate of Abatement and Reduction of Taxes Heretofore Levied for the Payment of Bonds shall be given effect according to their terms.

<u>Section 2</u>. Filing of Ordinance. Forthwith upon the adoption of this ordinance, the City Clerk shall file certified copies hereof with the County Clerks of DeKalb and Kendall Counties, Illinois, and it shall be the duty of said County Clerks to abate said taxes levied for the year 2024 in accordance with the provisions hereof.

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Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its passage by the Corporate Authorities and signing and approval by the Mayor.

CITY OF SANDWICH ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE ORDINANCE NO. 2024-17

An Ordinance levying taxes for all corporate purposes for the City of Sandwich, DeKalb and Kendall Counties, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025, and ending April 30, 2026.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SANDWICH, DEKALB & KENDALL COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION ONE. That the amounts hereinafter set forth, or so much therof as may be authorized by law, and the same are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the municipality as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, and for such purposes as: general corporate purposes, EMA, audit, FICA, IMRF, tort, workers compensation, unemployment, forestry, school crossing guards, street lighting, police protection and police pension for the fiscal year of the City of Sandwich, DeKalb & Kendall County, Illinois, beginning May 1, 2025, and ending April 30, 2026.

SECTION TWO. The requested levy amount of the One Million, Eight-Hundred Sixty-One Thousand, Six-Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,861,650) is hereby levied upon all the taxable property in the City of Sandwich subject to taxation for the current year. The amount levied for each object and purpose is placed in a separate column under the heading "Amounts to be Raised by Tax Levy," which appears over same being as follows, to wit:
