STAFF UPDATES

John's Updates:

John speaks on storm damage. Tickle Creek trail bridge 1 sustained some damage. The lights and park side had minimal damage.

Winterfest numbers are up this year. 23,500 visits so far. In 2024 we had approximately 17,000.

We had approximately 800 visitors for the Santa in Sandy event. Saturday was the 2nd night of the holiday market and had a couple thousand people come through.

A question is asked about people visiting from outside the Sandy Area. John says the data shows heavy 97055 but also people coming from the Portland metro area and Washington, even out of state, plus we've heard of people attending from Wilsonville.

Winterfest has had the tree lighting, pet pictures with the grinch, santa in Sandy, and 2 vendor markets so far. Up next we have shortest day walkway, stocking stroll through downtown Sandy with 32 participating businesses, 2 more vendor markets and Jolly Trolley nights. Jingle Jog is January 3rd with Holiday Happy Hour that evening, announcing the winners of the Merry Makeover Challenge.

John thanks Don and Kim for their service to the Parks Board. The Board will welcome a new member in January.
