1. Consideration and possible action on Ordinance No. 05-19-26, Canvassing the results of a General Election held on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing candidates to the office of City Council. *(Consideración y posible acción sobre la Ordenanza No. 05-19-26, Sondeo de los resultados de una Elección General celebrada el 2 de mayo del 2026, con el propósito de elegir candidatos para el cargo de Concejo Municipal.)*
2. Consideration and possible action on Ordinance No. 05-20-26, Canvassing the results of a Special Election held on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of Sanger, Texas, a Joint Ballot Proposition determining the abolition of the Sales and Use Tax collected for the Sanger Industrial Development Corporation (sidc), a Type A Economic Development Sales Tax, at the rate of one-half of one percent (0.50%), contingent upon the creation of a Municipal Development District (MDD) at the rate of one-half of one percent (0.50%) within the City's Corporate Limits and the City's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ). *(Consideración y posible acción sobre la Ordenanza nº 05-20-26, que examina los resultados de una elección especial celebrada el 2 de mayo de 2026, con el fin de presentar a los votantes cualificados de la ciudad de Sanger, Texas, una Propuesta de Votación Conjunta que determine la abolición del Impuesto sobre Ventas y Uso recaudado para la Sanger Industrial Development Corporation (SIDC), un Impuesto sobre Ventas de Desarrollo Económico Tipo A, a una tasa de medio uno por ciento (0,50%), condicionada a la creación de un Distrito de Desarrollo Municipal (MDD) a una tasa de*

medio uno por ciento (0,50%) dentro de los Límites Corporativos de la Ciudad y la Jurisdicción Extraterritorial (ETJ) de la Ciudad.)
