1. Training on Land-Use Provided by the Office of Property Rights Ombudsman. Rob Terry, Statewide Land-Use Training Director

Rob Terry, Utah Statewide Land Use Training Director, presented the Land-Use Law & Processes training to the commission. He recommended the website luau.utah.gov as a source for planning policy. Rob taught that Land Use Development & Management Act (LUDMA) is the base for all cities, municipalities, and state in the development of land-use policies. He taught that the General Plan is a mandated (but living) document that guides the growth and development of your community. Planning & Zoning Commissions are required in every county in the state.

2. Airbuild, Inc. Infrastructure Pods. John Buccer, AirBuilds, Reagan Wytsalucy, USU Extension, and Talia Hansen, Economic Development Manager

Reagen Wytsalucy, USU Faculty and County Extension Office, John Buccer, AirBuild Operations leader, and Talia Hansen, Economic presented the AirBuild Infrastructure Pods discussion to the commission. John spoke about the company AirBuild and carbon capture. They are building a small plant in Green River for the purpose of cleaning their river water and sewage. The company wants to compete with water plants by installing their equipment instead of a building a new water treatment plant. They use the algae to clean the water, eventually turning it into biochar. The company uses carbon capture credits to off set their carbon footprint. Reagen talked about regenerative agricultural and the positive impact that it may have on our health. She wants to find solutions for each resident to have food, energy, and sewage.
