NEW BUSINESS

3. City Hall Time Capsule-50 Year
 - Community Services Director John Bradley showed the board members some of the books they want to put in the time capsule. He also went over some of the ideas that Board Member Ron Jones had for putting in the time capsule.
 - Community Services Director John Bradley and Board Member Damon Bahr discussed different items that could be put in the time capsule.
4. Old Junior High Status
 - Mayor Dan Olson gave the board members an update on all the projects he has been working on.
 - Mayor Dan Olson gave the board members an update on the status of the old Junior High. He talked about the conversations he's had with board chair Ron Jones. He talked about looking at the long-term picture and using money and resources to restore the museum.
