Mayor & Council,

Utah State Code Ann. 10.6.117 states that municipal budget expenditures cannot exceed revenues for each of its funds or departments. Historically, at the end of the fiscal year Santaquin City analyzes its financial statement for both revenues and expenditures that have come in higher than anticipated and ensures that the budget remains balanced with enough revenues in each fund and department to cover all expenditures.
