Until then, get out and enjoy everything this Sprinter has to offer!



Management Council approves new Select Committee on Gaming

The Management Council met on April 8 in Cheyenne to discuss interim topics. An initial motion changed the tone of the day and the interim as the Council moved to allow the Chairman the ability to set their interim topics but also restricted meeting days from six to four. Chairman can request for additional days through the Council if needed. Final interim topics have been posted on wyoleg.gov and can be found here.

Along with priorities, the Council authorized Mental Health and Vulnerable Adult Task Force, Air Transportation Liaison Committee and the Select Committee on Legislative Facilities Technology and Process. Additionally, they created a new Select Committee Gaming appointing Senator John Kolb, Chairman, Senator Barry Crago, Senator Troy McKeown, Representative Jayme Lien, Chairman, Representative Steve Johnson, and Representative Joe Webb to serve. The Select Committee has yet to schedule meetings but will focus on local control and gaming revenues.
