with legal counsel for the Board of Police and Fire Commissioners who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the Board of Police and Fire Commissioners with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved.

Specifically, the Commission will review, discuss, deliberate, and take potential action, including rendering a decision regarding, the initial disciplinary hearing for a police officer that was performed by a hearing examiner appointed by the Board of Police and Fire Commissioners, including discussions with legal counsel regarding a likely court appeal of that decision; and to discuss and take possible action regarding the filing of new disciplinary charges against a police officer by the Chief of Police.

RECONVENE IN OPEN SESSION

8. Motion to reconvene in open session to take action, if any, regarding closed session business, including potentially announcing the decision, if any, of the Board of Police and Fire Commissioners regarding the initial disciplinary hearing for a police officer that was performed by a hearing examiner appointed by the Board of Police and Fire Commissioners, and discussion and possible action related to scheduling a hearing, or the appointment of a hearing examiner, for new charges filed against a police officer.
