KINGSTON SHALL NOT BE SUBJECTED TO THE HUMANE SOCIETY CARE FOR MORE THAN THIRTY (30) DAYS. IF NOT ABLE TO REHOME OR RELOCATE, THE HUMANE SOCIETY SHALL BE PERMITTED TO EUTHANIZE KINGSTON. PENDING RELEASE TO THE HUMANE SOCIETY, KINGSTON SHALL BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES WHEN NOT ON THE OWNER'S PROPERTY AND SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED IN ANY CITY PARK OR PUBLIC EVENT SPACE.
