Resident/Facility Lift Assist Fee:

- These are coded as **17A04 EMD Card** assists (based on Emergency Medical Dispatch guidelines).

- **Next Three Lifts (4-6):** \$50.00.
- **Next Three Lifts (7-9):** \$100.00.
- **After the Ninth Lift:** \$150.00 for each additional assist.

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Sheboygan Fire Department – Proposed 2026 Ambulance Rate Increase

- **No rate increase in 2025** – The last adjustment was made in 2024.
- **2026 increase aligns with statewide standards** – We compare with other fire-based EMS services to ensure competitiveness.
- **Resident vs. Non-Resident Fees** – Non-residents pay **\$200 above resident rates**.

BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:

The Sheboygan Fire Department has not adjusted ambulance rates since 2024. No increase was made in 2025. The proposed 2026 rate adjustment is designed to ensure financial sustainability, maintain competitiveness with comparable Wisconsin fire-based EMS providers, and continue delivering high-quality advanced life support (ALS), basic life support (BLS), and specialty transport services.

STAFF COMMENTS:

- The Fire Chief is requesting the ambulance fee adjustment approval.
- The last increase in ambulance billing was 2024.
- Adjustments reflect increased costs of personnel, equipment, training, and operations.
- Resident vs. non-resident rate differentiation remains in place to reduce taxpayer burden.
- The Fire Chief will continue to review the ambulance fee structure with the City Administrator on an annual basis.
- Rates are benchmarked against comparable Wisconsin fire department EMS providers.
