1. Call to Order
Quinn called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m. and determined there was a quorum.
2. Exclusion Appeal from Gilbert Clark
Code of Conduct policy, Clark's letter of exclusion and the Exclusion Appeal Form were discussed. The Board recognized that Clark had already served 2 months on his exclusion term. After discussion, Kuck **moved** to reduce Clark's original six-month exclusion to time already served. Quinn **seconded** the motion. Motion **passed**. Effective April 24, 2026, Clark will be allowed back into Mead Public Library.
3. Exclusion Appeal from Daquarius Harrell
Harrell failed to appear at the hearing to appeal his exclusion. Per Mead's Exclusion and Appeals Policy 10.03, dated September 22, 2022, *If the person fails to attend the hearing without prior notification to the Library Director, the original exclusion will stand, with no further option to appeal.* Harrell will have no further option to appeal.

Alvarez **moved** to approve minutes from June 23, 2023. Quinn **seconded**. Motion **passed**.
