#### **BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:**

Quarterly Benchmarks from the Fire Department for the period commencing January 1, 2023 and ending March 31, 2023 is presented for information and discussion as required by section 50-564 of the Municipal Code.

#### **STAFF COMMENTS:**

Highlights of the First Quarter of 2023 are as follows:

- Total call volume is 81 incidents lower than first quarter of 2022
- Total fire inspections were up by 906 compared to last year as a result of light-duty assignments and rolling out the inspection program earlier
- Fire training hours are significantly higher than last year as a result of new training software with more accurate documentation as well as additional emphasis on training
- Mutual Aid Received for YTD 2022 was not reported until Quarter 3 of the same year.

## **BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:**

The Quarterly Report of Benchmarks for the Police Department for the Period commencing January 1, 2023 and ending March 30, 2023 is presented for information and discussion as required by section 54-65 of the Municipal Code.

#### **STAFF COMMENTS:**

The report has been reformatted due to Aldermanic request and the crime data being presented has been changed from Summary data to Incident Based Reporting data. The FBI mandated that law enforcement agencies transition to Incident Based Reporting by 2021. The Sheboygan Police Department transitioned to Incident Based Reporting in 2018, however we have continued to report summary data for comparison purposes. Now that we have 5 years of Incident Based data we will be reporting from this data set on our quarterly and annual reports.

Highlights of the report are as follows:

- Part 1 Crime: There was an increase in Part 1 crime year to date in comparison to the same period in 2022 (175 vs.170). This is due to an increase in aggravated assaults during the period of 31 vs. 21 in 2022.
- Traffic accidents year to date (375 vs. 342) were up slightly in comparison to 2022, but are trending down.
- There was a decrease in involuntary commitments year to date in comparison to the same period in 2022 (33 vs. 37).

A RESOLUTION authorizing acceptance of the 2023 Wisconsin Bureau of Transportation Safety, Bicycle and Pedestrian Enforcement Grant.

WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan Police Department has the opportunity to obtain a grant in the total amount of \$20,000 from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, to assist in developing the city's capacity to provide additional patrols engaging in high visibility enforcement of bicycle and pedestrian violations; and

WHEREAS, in 2021 there were 1,404 motor vehicle collisions with pedestrians in Wisconsin, causing 63 fatalities and injuring 1,261 pedestrians. This amounts to a rate of one pedestrian killed or injured in Wisconsin every 7 hours. Pedestrian street crossings are the most common cause of such crashes, especially when drivers are distracted or pedestrians move into traffic unexpectedly; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the grant in the amount of \$20,000, it was necessary for the Police Chief to submit an application through the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety; and

WHEREAS, the funding received would be \$20,000 from State sources with a local match of 25% required; and

WHEREAS, the 25% match would be met within the current Police Department Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City of Sheboygan Common Council authorizes the Chief of Police to sign all documents necessary for the grant application and the administration thereof.

#### **BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:**

The Bureau of Transportation Safety notified the Sheboygan Police Department of eligibility for a \$20,000.00 grant from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for enforcement of bicycle and pedestrian safety rules. The grant supports additional police patrols to focus on bicycle and pedestrian safety by reimbursing the city for the cost of officers assigned to such patrols on overtime.

## **STAFF COMMENTS:**

The grant requires a 25% local match, which the Police Department can support within its current operational budget. The grant will be used to support overtime patrols in our bar district during weekend evenings and at other outdoor community events where there is an increase in pedestrian traffic in the roadways. Patrols will focus on ensuring pedestrian safety and addressing conditions that increase risk of pedestrian-involved crashes.
