#### **BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:**

The Quarterly Report of Benchmarks for the Police Department for the Period commencing January 1, 2025, and ending March 31, 2025, is presented for information and discussion as required by section 30-50 of the Municipal Code.

#### **STAFF COMMENTS:**

Highlights of the report are as follows:

- Crimes against persons are trending favorably compared to the same period last year, with four fewer aggravated assaults than last year at this time.
- Property crimes are higher than at this point last year, mostly due to an increase in reported retail thefts. Additionally, a small increase in robberies and vehicle thefts were cleared with several arrests.
- Vehicle crashes are considerably lower than last year, likely due to a milder winter and sustained targeted traffic enforcement.
- Involuntary mental health commitments continue to decrease as a result of our partnership with Sheboygan County and Elevate to implement our co-responder program.
- Our ability to issue parking tickets was interrupted by the recovery from the city's network outage and total numbers will be considerably lower than normal this year.

Quarterly Benchmarks from the Fire Department for the period commencing January 1, 2025 and ending March 31, 2025 is presented for information and discussion as required by section 24-459 of the Municipal Code.

#### **STAFF COMMENTS:**

Highlights of the First Quarter of 2025 are as follows:

- Total call volume is 137 incidents higher than first quarter of 2024.
- Fire inspections began earlier this year than in 2024 with this being the second year on the new fire reporting program (First Due).
- School safety programs will reflect 0 until traditional programs begin in fall. Other public events in the winter/spring season typically occur as requested.
- Fire training hours are 700 hours higher than previous due to continued efforts to record training data in new program.
