ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION

6. Review, discussion, and possible action to amend the bylaws as they relate to the preliminary hearing/response process.

The Commission would like to better clarify the bylaws as they relate to the process of preliminary hearing timelines within Sec 7.1.b.

Attorney Hagen provided two options to the commission:

- 1) **“b. Notice of Meeting.** The Commission shall set a date for a preliminary meeting not less than ten (10) nor more than thirty (30) days following delivery of notice of the preliminary meeting to the complainant and the accused.”
- 2) **“b. Scheduling of Meeting.** The Commission shall set a date for a preliminary meeting not less than ten (10) nor more than (30) days following the filing of charges.”

The Commission discussed their options but determined that neither were suitable at this time. The Commission requested that City Attorney Majerus connect with the Independent Hearing Officer (IHO) for recommendation of how to amend the bylaws. The Commission moved to table item 6 until that can be done.

7. Update on the IHO's progress regarding the scheduling hearing and evidentiary hearing.

The hearing dates have been scheduled for June 17, June 23, and June 24, 2026. The hearing will be held at City Hall in the third floor Council Chambers and is scheduled to start at 9am each day.

8. Discussion and possible action on the *Police and Fire Commission Complaint of Employee Misconduct* form.

The Commission is satisfied with the form but discussed minor edits. Those edits included updating the formatting of the title so that the heading was correctly centered on the form.

Another Commissioner suggested the form have a space where the complainant can put the policy number or section they feel is being violated. The Commission discussed that they did not want to make it a requirement due to fears that would hinder or inhibit someone from submitting the form. Instead, it was brought to their attention that there is a space on the form to include an optional attachment of the policy information.

The Commission is satisfied with the form but discussed a few edits. The first edit was regarding the title "Firefighter". The Commission would like the first mention of the title Firefighter to be written as "Firefighter/Paramedic (referred to as Firefighter from here forward)". The goal of this revision is to provide clarity to the user of this document that staff with the Sheboygan Fire Department are both Firefighters and Paramedics, but the document will just refer to them as Firefighters for simplicity.

Additionally, the Commission would like to strike the word "can" and replace it with "may" in paragraph 3 so that the sentence reads "complaint may be filed...".
