2. Accessory Dwelling Unit Regulation Update: Staff identified areas where the municipal code is inconsistent with new state legislation, HB1337, regarding Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU). Staff emphasized the part of legislation that allows for two ADUs per lot and primary units no longer must be owner occupied. Council discussed definitions of alley and ADU. The impacts of the new legislation on the floodway and floodplain were elaborated on by staff. Council requested that Planning Commission begin to consider updating the city's ADU regulations.
