APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION by Commissioner Hansen; **SECONDED** by Commissioner Cronk to approve the minutes of April 18, 2024. Motion passed unanimously.

- Plein Air Paint Out: Promoting to artist organizations. Consider posting pictures of bridges on website for clarity. City Hall Art Gallery will feature past Plein Air Paint Out winning paintings. Judge needed.
- Art Classes: September 22, senior/55+, watercolor beginner class, held at Snoqualmie Library, function of partnership between Snoqualmie Arts Commission and KCLS. Idea for 2025, senior/55+ focused class on plein air technique in spring/early summer 2025.
- City Hall Art Gallery: Artist YiJu Miller featured artist. May 28, 6pm, reception.

OTHER BUSINESS

- Pop-Up Piano Painting: Snoqualmie Arts Commission to support local artist and youth painting a piano located in Historic Downtown Snoqualmie.
- Building Mural Update: Landlord of proposed building has agreement, since February 2024.
