### **CALL TO ORDER**

Commissioner Erisman noted the prior commission had a clear objective but there has been much more discussion with this commission. He also noted they should be prepared with a statement indicating what they did and why they did it. This will reflect the scope is not unreasonable based on comparable cities. It was agreed there has been good discussion and progress.
