3. **ACHD IFYWP-** Committee reviewed the draft ACHD IFYWP. Several suggestions were made to modify this year's comments. Moved by Burton, second by Turnipseed to recommend the Council approve submitting the IFYWP to ACHD including the suggested revisions. Motion passed. The Mayor will make the changes and submit it to the City Council for approval at the February 20,2024 City Council meeting.
4. **HWY 16 –(Hwy 44 to Emmett) Environmental Study cross section review-** Mayor is planning to meet with ITD in March to discuss alternatives for the Floating Feather/HWY 16 intersection.
5. **Pathway Master Plan Update** - Ryan Morgan reported the agreement has been signed and that he expects a kickoff meeting soon.
6. **Pathway Agreement Update-** The Mayor has received a final version of Drainage District No. 2 Agreement for pathways. It is identical to the Middleton Mill agreement. The Mayor plans to put it on the City Council agenda for approval February 20.

 - a. **HD4 Update Items-**Bruce Bayne reported HD\$ is working on the design to connect gap in Blessinger at the top of the hill. They also plan to ultimately remove the gap on Kingsbury.
