Guidelines for Public Comment

Public Comment ensures an opportunity for citizens to meaningfully participate in the decisions of its elected officials. It is one of several ways your voice is heard by your local government. During public comment we ask that all participants respect the right of others to make their comment uninterrupted. The council's goal is to receive as much comment as time reasonably allows. All public comment should be directed to the chair (Mayor or designee). Comment made to the audience or individual council members may be ruled out of order. Public comment must remain on topic, and free from abusive language or unsupported allegations.

During any council meeting you have two opportunities to comment:

1. During the public comment period near the beginning of a meeting.
2. Before any decision-making vote of the council on an agenda item.

Comment made outside of these times may not be allowed.

Citizens wishing to speak during the official public comment period should come forward to the podium and state their name and address for the record. Comment during this time maybe time limited, as determined by the chair, to allow as many people as possible to comment. Citizens wishing to comment on a motion for decision before any vote can come forward or stand in place as they wish. Comment must remain on the motion before the council.

Sewer and Water Advisory Committee Meeting

April 21st, 2026

Roll Call: Brinda, Bruce, Jim, Melissa, Wally Smith, and Cindy Brown.

Melissa added that Sue Devlin had stepped down from the committee.

Item a. Discussion/Decision: Approval of Water and Sewer Committee Meeting minutes from 04.17.2026

Approval W&S Committee Meeting Minutes from 04.07.2026. Motion to approve and seconded. None opposed. Cindy and Wally abstained from the vote.

Item b. Discussion/Decision: Approval of Water and Sewer Committee Bylaws

The Bylaws were returning for final approval after discussion of a few minor changes at the last meeting. Motion to approve and seconded. None opposed. Cindy Brown abstained from the vote.

Item c. Discussion: Finance Department Overview of Water & Sewer Accounts

Melissa stated that Robert and Gina would have to reschedule their presentation to March 19th. She apologized, she was not aware of their rescheduling until moments before tonight's meeting or she would have called to cancel the meeting. More to come on the 19th.

Melissa reported that she has heard that it would be ok for the committee members to take a tour of the town infrastructure related to water and sewer as one whole group, with appropriate public notice given. She would work on that with a goal of the tour being schedule during the next meeting on May 5th.

Members discussed the ongoing water issues with clarity in water after the recent water and power outages at Creekside. Melissa encouraged members to bring their questions for Steve at our next meeting on May 5th, and to even send the questions ahead of time so Steve can have time to gather his thoughts. She also stated that perhaps the tour be just a simple tour, and to ask Steve to attend another meeting for a Q&A. Questions included state regulatory requirements for water and sewage handling, water sample results, and compiling a list of locations that might be toured.

Brinda also detailed that she had heard about a Burnt Fork Water Committee in the Bitterroot Star, advertised for the public to attend. Melissa added that a quick internet search detailed the committee reviewed irrigation for farmers in the area.
