- Brand: Dotto
- Includes power unit and four trailers (each trailer holds 28 passengers)
- Designed specifically for people moving (112 passenger capacity total)
- Steam whistle and train bell
- Excellent condition
- New paint
- Stick shift
- New tires
- New brakes (air-over-hydraulic)
- Vinyl seats and backs in trailers
- Low floors for easy access
- Power unit seats driver and one passenter
- All manuals are also included
- 1989 Four Cylinder Diesel Engine
- Hood hinges to expose engine
- Runs approximately 15 miles per hour with governor
- Tight turning radius is 19'6"
- All the trailers have articulated steering
