The City of St. Helens is completing the Columbia Pacific Food Bank Renovation Project funded with Community Development Block Grant funds from the Oregon Business Development Department. The location of the project is 1421 Columbia Blvd. It is estimated that the project will benefit at least 19,981 persons annually of whom 100 percent are low or moderate income. This is based on the estimated number of people served in 2021.

The purpose of the hearing is for the St. Helens City Council to obtain citizens views about the project and to take comments about the local government's performance. Written comments are also welcome and must be received by 5:00 p.m. on July 20, 2022 at 265 Strand Street. Both oral and written comments will be reviewed by the St. Helens City Council.
