The Council did not enter into Executive Session.

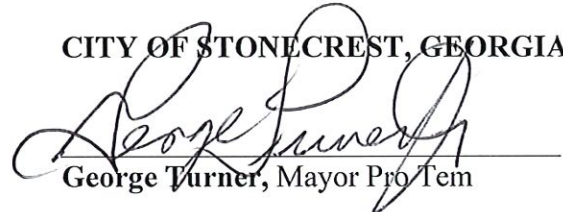
VI. ADJOURNMENT
