b. Review and Discussion of Article II.

Government Structure, Elections, And Legislative Branch and Article III: Executive Branch

- Change of Government Structure

No change proposed.

Motion – made by Joel Thibodeaux to author the language to include that this is a Council, City Manager form of government.

Second by LaShawnda Walker.

Motion passed unanimously.

- Change of Mayoral Powers

Amending Article III , section 3.01 of the amended Charter to include section (a) (1), (2), (3), (4) (5) (7) (10) and (11) (no letter a is enumerated but the language from the word “Perform” and ending with “charter” in the first part of (11) from article III section 301 (a) of SB 208 (original charter) and to strike/ not include section (a) (6), (8), (9), (11)(b) and (c) from SB 208 (original charter) in the amended charter language. Section 4 and 6 of the current amended charter were specifically retained.

Motion – made by Kirby Clements to amend the charter to include the proposed revisions.

Second by LaShawnda Walker.

Motion passed unanimously.

- Clarify and/or Enumerate Oversight Functions over City Administration

Proposals were made to change section 3.03 of amended charter subsections (b)(2) to list the City Manager as the full-time Chief Administrative Officer instead of Chief Executive Officer. It was also proposed to add language under City Administration stating council shall annually articulate the terms of evaluation of the City Manager. All other language remains the same for section 3.03. No vote taken.

c. Q4 Work Plan

Chair Thibodeaux stated he would like to get some heavy lifting done prior to the holidays.

d. Schedule and approval of the next Commission meeting date

Chair Thibodeaux stated he would like to call another meeting the week of October 13th to come back to address proposals and start approving language. Kirby Clements may not be present at the next meeting.


