- **Call to Order:** Chair, Katy Eichenberg, called the meeting to order in the Stephenville Public Library at 5:09pm.
- **Minutes:** Kate Barton made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 19, 2021 meeting. Jo Ann Phillips seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Apollo Computer Proposal: Katy Eichenberg reported that Kelli spoke with the city IT staff regarding Apollo's assessment and proposal for upgrades to the existing library computers. The city IT staff advised that for security reasons, any work on the computers be conducted internally and not by an outside agency.
- Vision and Plan for the Library: Several members of the board submitted feedback for long-term planning purposes. Mary also shared a one-year and five-year plan that she drafted with the previous director of parks and leisure and library staff. It was agreed by common consent that a top priority is development of a library logo.
