# ORDINANCE AMENDING § 7-6.2 OF THE GENERAL REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF TINTON FALLS GOVERNING STOP INTERSECTIONS TO INCLUDE A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF TERRY LANE AND WILLIAM STREET

WHEREAS, a request was made by the Tinton Falls Police Department's traffic division for the installation of a stop sign on Terry Lane at the William Street intersection so that traffic exiting Terry Lane must stop for William Street traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police made a recommendation for the placement of such a stop sign, which has been reviewed by the Borough's engineer who concurs with the Chief's recommendation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Tinton Falls in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that § 7-6.2 of the General Revised Ordinances of the Borough of Tinton Falls be and are hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

#### SECTION 1. Amendment to § 7-6.2.

#### 7-6.2. Stop Intersections.

Pursuant to the provision of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the intersections described below are hereby designated as Stop Intersections. STOP signs shall be installed as provided therein.

Terry Lane and William Street
STOP sign shall be installed on Terry Lane

#### SECTION 2. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

#### SECTION 3. Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

#### SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.

Therefore, from an engineering standpoint, I have no objection to the release of the maintenance bond in the amount of \$132,297.77.

Scope and Fee Estimate

Dear Mr. Skudera:

T&M Associates is pleased to submit this Scope and Fee Estimate for Professional Services associated with the Borough's 2018 Road Improvement Program. It is our understanding that the Borough has budgeted a total of \$2,356,800 for improvements to a number of streets throughout the Borough, as well as sidewalk along Tinton Avenue/Wayside Road. The following is the proposed scope of improvements for the 2018 Road Improvement Program:

#### Water Street: Tinton Avenue west to the Colts Neck Municipal Boundary

Based on the existing conditions of this roadway, we anticipate construction to be a mix of full width mill and overlay and full depth reconstruction. Most of the western half of the road beyond Marissa Lane is in better condition and will only need a mill and overlay. The remaining portions of the road will likely require full depth reconstruction, especially along the road edges that have deteriorated over time. In areas of reconstruction, the road will be re-profiled and regraded to eliminate areas of standing water and an uneven crown. The road will be widened where possible (however, based on existing constraints, these areas may be limited).

Slope stabilization will be added where runoff travels off the road into the adjacent stream. The substandard existing guiderail will be analyzed and replaced where necessary. Handicap accessible curb ramps will be constructed in accordance with current ADA standards, and inlets heads and grates will be replaced with ones that comply with NJDEP requirements. Asphalt driveway aprons will be provided for any existing dirt or stone driveways.

Steven Avenue: Entire Length Howard Avenue: Entire Length Cross Way: Entire Length South Terrace: Entire Length

Based on the condition of these roadways, we anticipate full depth pavement reconstruction consisting of base course and surface course. Handicap accessible curb ramps will be constructed in accordance with current ADA standards where necessary, and inlets heads and grates will be replaced with ones that comply with NJDEP requirements. Fox Chase Drive: Asbury Avenue to Filly Way (north end)

Springdale Avenue: Entire Length

Based on the condition of these roadways, we anticipate full width milling and resurfacing. Full depth base repair and pavement reconstruction will be required in isolated areas of pavement failure. Handicap accessible curb ramps will be constructed in accordance with current ADA standards where necessary, and inlets heads and grates will be replaced with ones that comply with NJDEP requirements. Driveway repairs and new aprons will be completed where necessary along Springdale Avenue.

Old Mill Road: Entire Length Marland Road: Entire Length Liberty Drive: Entire Length

Based on the condition of these roadways, we anticipate full width milling and resurfacing. Full depth base repair and pavement reconstruction will be required in isolated areas of pavement failure. Due to high groundwater and/or roof leader and sump pump discharges, underdrain pipes will be constructed in areas of these roadways to help alleviate excess water along the road edges. Areas of deteriorated concrete curb and driveway aprons will be replaced where necessary, and inlets heads and grates will be replaced with ones that comply with NJDEP requirements. No ADA ramps require replacement on these roads.

## Wheeling Court: Entire Length Wyckham Road: Entire Length

Based on the condition of these roadways, we anticipate full width milling and resurfacing. Full depth base repair and pavement reconstruction will be required in isolated areas of pavement failure. No concrete or driveway work is anticipated on these roads. Wyckham Road will be designed, but bid as an Add Alternate and only awarded if funds allow.

#### Tinton Avenue/Wayside Road Sidewalks

Sidewalk will be added along the western side of Tinton Avenue and Wayside Road where currently missing to provide a continuous sidewalk path from Water Street south to Rutgers Drive. Handicap accessible curb ramps will be constructed in accordance with current ADA standards where necessary. Small retaining walls may be required along certain sections of the new sidewalk.

#### **Traffic Calming Measures**

Striping improvements will be added along Heritage Boulevard and Rutgers Drive in an effort to curtail speeding. Striping improvements could consist of centerline and edge striping, cross hatch striping within the shoulder area, crosswalk upgrades, etc. We will also review the possibility of a curb bumpout on Heritage Boulevard at Cannonball Drive with Borough Officials.

Restoration and cleanup, including topsoiling, fertilizing and seeding, will be included at all locations.

Based on the scope of work outlined above, we anticipate construction costs to be in the vicinity of two million dollars.

In order to achieve the Borough's objectives, we propose the following scope of services.

#### A. PRE-DESIGN PHASE

- 1. Complete field surveys for Water Street and Tinton Avenue/Wayside Road will be acquired by conventional "on the ground" methods. Pavement cross-sections will be provided at 50 foot intervals, and the surveys will indicate all topography up to 15 feet beyond the edge of pavement. For the remaining streets, base maps will be prepared using aerial mapping.
- 2. We will coordinate a pavement coring program in order to determine the depth of the existing pavement on all roads. Approximately 75 cores will be obtained and reviewed.
- 3. Copies of the base maps will be forwarded to each utility company so they can verify the location and sizes of their facilities. We will also inquire whether they have plans for future relocation or expansion. We also suggest that the Borough verify that sanitary sewer facilities are in good condition.

- 1. Once field surveys have been completed and base maps prepared at a scale of 1" = 30', a preliminary design for each street and the new sidewalk will be prepared and will include the following items:
  - a. Graphical horizontal geometry denoting pavement widths, limits of curbing, approximate limits of reconstruction, and existing right-of-way lines based on Borough Tax Maps.
  - b. Proposed typical sections.
  - c. A preliminary construction cost estimate.
  - d. The preliminary plans will be reviewed with appropriate Borough officials prior to proceeding with final design.

  - a. Title sheet with key map;

- 3. Quantities will be estimated by item, and a final construction cost estimate will be provided.
- 4. Specifications will be prepared in book form, in T&M Associates' format, based on the 2007 New Jersey Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.
- 5. An application for soil erosion and sediment control certification will be prepared and submitted by T&M Associates to the Freehold Soil Conservation District on behalf of the Borough. Any application fees will be paid separately by the Borough and are not included in this proposal. We anticipate the permit fee to be approximately \$5,100. We do not anticipate that any other permits will be required by the Borough for this project. If it is determined during design that any NJDEP permits are required, a separate scope and fee estimate will be provided for those services. The Contractor will be responsible for obtaining a Monmouth County Road Opening Permit for any work on Tinton Avenue/Wayside Road.
- 6. We will coordinate with Monmouth County to review the plans and specifications for those roadways or sidewalks that intersect County roadways.
- 7. We will submit final plans and specifications to the Borough for final review prior to the preparation of bid documents.

#### C. BIDDING PHASE

- 1. Upon completion of the plans and specifications, we will present the project to the Borough requesting approval and authorization to advertise the project for bids. T&M Associates will print and distribute the contract documents, including final plans and specifications, to prospective contractors. The cost of the printing will be offset by the purchase price of the plans and specifications.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Tinton Falls is currently responsible for 14 sanitary sewer pump stations; and

WHEREAS, all of these pump stations require a remote monitoring/autodialer system to notify personnel of emergency situations such as a power failure or high water level; and

WHEREAS, Soldier On is a nationally recognized non-profit organization that works in partnership with the Department of Veterans Affairs and other agencies to provide housing and supportive services for veterans; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is the owner of real property 12.59 acre +/- located at Block 128.03, Lot 5 (the "Property"), which Soldier On has expressed the desire to construct the Gordon H. Mansfield Village which would provide affordable veterans housing (the "Development"); and

- (3) It hereby adopts the within Resolution with the further intent and purpose that from the date of execution of the Agency mortgage, the proposed Project, including both the land and improvements thereon, will be exempt from real property taxation as provided in the HMFA Requirements, provided that payments in lieu of taxes for municipal services supplied to the Project are made to the municipality in such amounts and manner set forth in the Agreement for Payments in Lieu of Taxes attached hereto as Exhibit B in an amount equal to five (5) percent of the Project Revenues as defined therein; and
