- 3) Award Equipment Purchases for WWTF
 - a) Grit Classifier, separates organic from non-organic. This piece of equipment is 24 years old. 1st by JG, 2nd by DP to purchase the recommended Trillium (Wemco) 304SS for \$69,725. This machine was the highest scoring on the list. All ayes. Motion approved.
 - b) Mechanical Bar Screen. 1st by DP, 2nd by JG, to purchase the Rec Vulcan ESR 304SS with 5 year warranty. This is the lowest bid and was the highest scorer. All ayes. Motion approved.
 - c) UV Disinfectant Lights, 1st by DP, 2nd by JG, to purchase the recommended Zylom Duram Model, with the lower bid and higher scoring. All ayes. Motion approved
- 4) Motion by DP, 2nd by JG to approve the suggested changes for Section 38 Streets, Sidewalks & Other Public Places and to send to Council for their approval. All ayes. Motion approved.
- 5) Motion by DP, 2nd by BR to approve the recommendation for the snowmobile trail and to present it in map format, and to send to Council for their approval. All ayes. Motion approved.

- b) Water- Average daily was 989,000 million gallons. Finished flushing the first week in October, the water looked remarkably better this time. Updated flow rate in the mapping system. SCADA system is up and running on the new system, they will be back in a couple weeks to finish up. The last system was installed in 2002. Meters that were back ordered are starting to come in. Attended a PFAS meeting via zoom with DNR and one with the EPA.
- c) Public Works- The replacement for Supervisor Bill Kobleska was chosen, Joe Kube has started training. Been very busy with blacktop patching, seeding and replacing sidewalk. Fixed storm sewer by the shop. Leaf pickup is going on. The leaf vac was down when the starter and clutch went out. Did some ditch cleaning on the north end. Two new truck drivers start on October 31.
- 1. Director's Report
 - a. Safety audit will take place on Oct 27 from 9-12 by DSPS.

Sec. 38-4. - Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Carriage walk means any walkway constructed between the sidewalk and the curb or lateral lines of a roadway.

Nonresidential property means all property other than property used exclusively as one-family and two-family dwellings.

Residential property means property used exclusively as one-family and two-family dwellings.

Sidewalk means the paved walk between the curblines or the lateral lines of a roadway and the adjacent property lines, constructed for the use of pedestrians. The term "sidewalk" shall not include carriage walks. (Code 1993, § 8.02)

Sec. 52-117. - Driveways.

All driveways installed, altered, changed, replaced or extended after the effective date of this chapter shall meet the following requirements:

- (1) Islands between driveway openings except in R-1, R-2, R-3 and B districts shall be provided with minimum of 12 feet between all driveways and three feet at all lot lines.
- (2) Openings for vehicular ingress and egress shall not exceed 35 feet at the roadway.
- (3) Vehicular entrances and exits to drive-in theaters, banks and restaurants, motels, funeral homes, vehicular sales, service, washing and repair stations; garages; or public parking lots shall be not less than 200 feet from any pedestrian entrance or exit to a school, college, university, church, hospital, park, playground, library, public emergency shelter or other place of public assembly.

(Code 1993, § 17.43)

- (a) Owners responsibility. The owner or occupant of any lot or parcel shall promptly each day, and in no event later than 24 hours after any snowstorm, remove all snow and ice which may have fallen or accumulated upon the sidewalk in front of such lot or parcel; provided, when ice has so formed that it cannot be removed, the owner or occupant shall keep the same sprinkled with a material which will prevent the sidewalk from being dangerous to pedestrians. This provision does not apply to the owner or occupant of any sidewalk 25 feet or more away from the respective property line of the owner or occupant.
- (b) City's option to clear sidewalks. In any case where the owner, occupant or person in charge of any building or structure or unoccupied lot shall fail to clear his respective sidewalk of snow and ice as set forth above, then and in that event, the city may elect to clear said sidewalks as follows:
 - (1) Written notice shall be delivered to and left in a conspicuous place on the premises informing said person of his failure to clear said sidewalk, the city's intention to clear the same and the potential costs thereof, no less than 24 hours prior to the city's clearing said sidewalk.
 - (2) The city shall clear or cause to be cleared all snow and ice from said sidewalk, and shall charge the expenses of so doing pursuant to a fee schedule established by the city council or designated city personnel, subject to approval by the city council. The charges shall be set forth in a statement to the clerk who, in turn, shall mail the same to the owner, occupant or person in charge of the subject premises. If said statement is not paid in full within 30 days thereafter, the statement shall be reported to the clerk, who shall enter the charges on the tax roll as a special tax against said lot or parcel of land, and the same shall be collected in all respects like other taxes upon real estate, or as provided under Wis. Stats. § 66.615(3)(f).
- (c) Deposit of snow on streets or sidewalks.
 - (1) No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow or ice taken and removed from his premises or elsewhere upon any sidewalk, alley, parkway, public place or street in the city, except snow removed from sidewalk areas where there are no boulevards or terraces. Snow shall not be piled at or near intersections so as to obstruct the view of pedestrians or operators of motor vehicles.
 - (2) No person shall remove or deposit any snow from building rooftops into a public alley, except by specific permission of the director of public works, and if such permission is granted, the deposited snow must be moved from the alley within a reasonable length of time to be designated by the director of public works at the time permission is granted.




