The Tomah Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District Commissioners met in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 819 Superior Avenue, Tomah, WI at 6:15 p.m. on November 10, 2020 to hold the Annual meeting of the Tomah Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District. The meeting was called to order by Lamont Kiefer.

The purpose of this meeting is as follows:

- 1) Approve the Minutes of the November 12, 2019 Meeting.
- 2) Approve a Budget for 2021.
- 3) Establish a tax levy upon all taxable property within the district for the cost of operation for the coming year.
- 4) Approve or disapprove all proposed projects by the District in excess of \$10,000.
- 5) Set the 2021 Annual meeting date.
- 6) To consider any other business as may come before the meeting.

Approximately 18 persons were present for this meeting: Mike Murray, Richard Yarrington, Shawn Zabinski, Lamont Kiefer, Jeff Cram, Donna Evans, Travis Scholze, Donna Evans, JoAnn Cram, Becki Weyer, Julia Mann, Pam Buchda, Mitch Koel, and Bob Kliebenstein. Tim Adler appeared remotely. The Lake Committee will be working with the Parks and Recreation Dept. to assist with parts of the Winnebago Master Plan and contributing funds.

1) **Minutes.** Motion by Murray, second by Evans by to approve the Minutes of the November 12, 2019 meeting. Motion carried without negative vote.

Approval of the Budget for 2021 and Establish Tax Levy. The proposed budget regarding the Lake District Fund was addressed. The proposed expenditures total \$65,440 which is significantly down from the 2020 Budget of \$111,160. The Proposed Levy is a total of \$63,685, compared to \$64,596 in 2020, a decrease of 1.41% which requires a levy rate of \$.094 per \$1,000 compared to.098 cents in 2020. This decrease is due to not having any big projects scheduled for 2021. There is \$66,361 projected in revenue from fund balance applied. Treasurer Mann spoke to the \$40,000 budgeted for geese management and projected the fund balance to be about \$311,000. There are bills still outstanding from Gerke's for dredging, and some funds have been allocated to the Winnebago Park project for the boat landing.

Motion by Evans, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Peterson to approve the budget for 2021 as presented. Motion passed without negative vote.

- 2) **Establish a Tax Levy.** Motion by Yarrington, second by Zabinski to establish a tax levy rate of \$ .0940374222 per \$1,000 of assessed value with the Lake District Tax Levy at \$63,685 for 2021. Motion carried without negative vote.
- 3) Approve or Disapprove all proposed projects by the District in excess of \$10,000. Motion by Zabinski, second by Evans that all projects proposed by the district in excess of \$10,000 must be brought back to the Commissioners for approval prior to the start of the project. Motion carried without negative vote. No projects are currently scheduled.
- 4) **2021 Meeting Date.** The regular Council meeting is supposed to be held on November 9, 2021. In the past it has been requested that the annual meeting be held in conjunction with the City Council meeting that has the public hearing for the city budget. It was the consensus of the Council to continue with that process. An alternate date would be Nov. 16, 2021.

Motion by Peterson, second by Evans to set the 2021 meeting for Nov. 9 and if necessary, a backup date of Nov. 16, 2021. Motion passed without negative vote.

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- 5) To consider any other such business as may come before this meeting. None.
- 7) Motion by Yarrington, second by Peterson to adjourn. Motion carried without negative vote. Meeting adjourned at 6:27 p.m.
