# **Grand Parkway Elevated Storage Tank**

### **Impact Fee Funded – Water**

- Description:
  - Construction of a 1.0MG Elevated Storage Tank (EST) and 16-inch water line to connect to the existing 12-inch line near the site location.
    - As agreed in the Development Agreement for Lovett Industrial, this project is funded 50% by the developer.
- Progress
  - All large components of the EST have been completed and the tank is operational.
  - We are currently awaiting the SCADA system to be installed.
    - Project is anticipated to be completed late 2025.

- Project Cost:

    - Construction: \$5,178,000

# 16" Water Line Hufsmith Road Impact Fee Funded – Water

### Description:

 Extend the 16" water line along E. Hufsmith from the drainage channel west to N. Cherry Street/Ulrich Road.

### • Progress:

- Design continues. Survey has been completed and contract with BNSF for the railroad crossing has been approved.
  - Staff anticipates design being completed third quarter 2025 with bid award pending fourth quarter 2025.

- Current Cost:
  - Engineering: \$346,382
  - Miscellaneous: \$6,366
- Estimated Project Cost
  - Construction: \$2,204,252
- Estimated Project Cost: \$2,557,000



# 16" Water Line – SH 249 Impact Fee Funded – Water (Reimbursement)

### Description:

 Construction of a 16-inch water line along SH 249 connecting at the Grand Parkway EST and extending north to Holderrieth Road.

### • Progress:

- Design continues and the survey is pending completion. Engineer is working with landowners for potential easement dedication.
  - Project is anticipated to be complete in FY 2026.
  - Project cost is to be reimbursed by the developer.

- Current Cost:
  - Engineering: \$448,420
- Estimated Project Cost
  - Land/Easement: \$668,280
  - Construction: \$3,510,392
- Estimated Project Cost: \$4,627,092



# Oak & Clayton Water Line Replacement Impact Fee Funded – Water

### Description:

 Construction of a new water line along Clayton Street to replace the existing 2-inch water line and a new water line along Oak Street to replace the existing 6-inch water line

### Progress:

- Design has been completed, and the project was bid in May with bids due on May 15, 2025.
- Construction contract was approved by City Council on June 16.
  - Construction start date is pending material delivery.

- Current Cost:
  - Engineering: \$140,000
- Estimated Project Cost
  - Construction: \$255,000
- Estimated Project Cost: \$395,000

# Rudolph Road Sanitary Sewer Extension Impact Fee Funded – Sanitary Sewer

### Description:

 Design and construction of approximately 1,000 LF of sanitary sewer along the west side of Rudolph Road north from E. Hufsmith.

### • Progress:

- Construction has been completed aside from site clean-up and maintenance.
  - Final project close out is scheduled for the end of June.

### Final Project Cost:

- Engineering: \$47,449
- Construction: \$148,394
- Total Project Cost: \$195,843

# **South Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion Bond Funded**

### • Description:

 Design and construction of the expansion of the existing South Wastewater Treatment Plant required by demand and TCEQ based on allocated permitting for daily flow. Plant is nearing 75% capacity which requires design. Based on the Wastewater Master Plan, the City will be nearing 90% capacity requiring an expansion. The proposed expansion is for 1.5mgd, making the total capacity 3.0mgd.

### Progress:

- GMP-1 (early works package) and construction phase engineering was approved by City Council on Feb. 3, 2025.
- GMP-2 (balance of plant) was approved by City Council on June 16.
  - Construction is scheduled to start in July 2025.

- Current Cost:
  - Engineering: \$10,203,585
  - Construction Phase I: \$59,335,366
  - Equipment: \$893,453
- Estimated Project Cost: \$70,432,404



## **East Water Plant**

### **Bond Funded**

- Description:
  - Design and construction of a new water plant, referred to as the East Water Plant, based on recommendations from the Water Master Plan completed in 2018. Progress:
  - Design has been completed and proposals were submitted to the City for construction.
  - City Council approved the construction contract on June 2.
    - Contractor is working on submittals and ordering material required to begin work.
    - Project is scheduled to be completed by November 2026.
