The Tualatin Planning Commission is asked to provide a recommendation to the Tualatin City Council regarding a Plan Text Amendment proposed by AKS Engineering on behalf of owners P3 Properties, LLC and Autumn Sunrise, LLC, as well as associated businesses Venture Properties and Lennar Northwest, Inc. The proposed Plan Text Amendment would modify the standards of the Medium Low-Density Residential (RML) zone to allow detached single-family residential dwellings as an outright Permitted rather than Conditional Use, applicable to development sites 15 acres or greater within the Basalt Creek area (south of SW Norwood Road, east of SW Boones Ferry Road). Other elements of the amendment include reduced lot sizes/lot size averaging and increased lot coverage. Maximum density would be unchanged.
