A. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Janet Steiger Carr called the meeting to order at 6:16pm.

B. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Minutes of the February 18, 2025 meeting were approved on a motion from Mason Hall and 2nd by Jeannie Hart

D. NEW BUSINESS

1. Van Tour of Traffic Signal Box Locations – the committee participated in a driving tour of ten different potential locations for signal box wrap installations. Upon returning, the committee identified three signal box locations and selected art for each. The locations selected include SW Herman Rd. at Teton Rd. (Seasonal Leaves), SW Tualatin Rd. at Sweek Rd. (Blue), and SW Martinazzi at Fred Meyer (Mt. Hood II). The committee also toured the recently completed Veterans Plaza and discussed the April sculpture installation and May 26 grand opening.
2. Committee Member Recognition – The committee thanked Dawn Upton for her nearly 15 years of service, and Jeannie Hart for her 3 years of service. Dawn Upton will also be recognized at the April 14 City Council meeting.
