DISCUSSION – DRAFT
FOCUS AREA WORK
PLANS:

Administrator Parks reviewed the overall structure and work plan previously completed during the June retreat sessions. With the assistance of Assistant Administrator Adams, Council was guided through a process to apply the prioritization criteria to a drafted focus area - a vibrant, livable and inclusive community.
