**Summary:** This item considers approval of a Street Right-of-Way Privilege Agreement allowing the property owners at 2320 Wilson Street to use a 20-foot portion of the unimproved 24th Street right-of-way as additional side-yard space.

# G. <u>25-249</u> Joint Powers Agreement Between Manitowoc County Joint Dispatch Center and City of Two Rivers

**Summary:** This agreement pertains to the dispatching of emergency services within Manitowoc County. All Counties with 911 services are required to file a Joint Powers Agreement on an annual basis to the Department of Justice.

# H. <u>25-250</u> Resolution Approving an Easement Agreement Between the City of Two Rivers and TPA VI, LLC in Regards to the 18th Street Cell Tower Property

**Summary:** This resolution authorizes the City to execute an easement agreement with TPA VI, LLC for the transfer of the City's interest in the 18th Street cell tower site in exchange for a \$305,000 lump-sum payment. It further authorizes the City Manager to sign the easement and all associated closing documents on behalf of the City.

#### 10. CITY COUNCIL - FORMAL ITEMS

A. <u>25-251</u> Consider Appeal for a Variance from the City Residency Restrictions Applicable to Sex Offenders, Per Chapter 9-9 of City Ordinances

**Summary:** City Council will consider a request for a waiver from the City's sex offender residency restrictions under Ordinance 9-9. The City recommends denial based on the nature of the offense, lack of qualifying exemptions or prior residency ties to the City, inaccuracies in the waiver request, and the applicant's decision to purchase a residence despite being aware of the ordinance and its restrictions.

### **Recommended Action:**

Motion to deny the appeal, consistent with the recommendation of the Chief of Police

B. <u>25-252</u> Ordinance to Amend Chapters 1-2-1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Two Rivers, Wisconsin, Fees, and Create Section 6-15 of the Municipal Code Titled "Weights and Measures"

**Summary:** This ordinance creates an annual weights & measures license for devices located or used within the City for the purpose of computing a charge or payment for services rendered on the basis of weight or measure. Operators of these weights and measures shall pay to the City the actual cost of incurred by the City in connection with inspecting said weights and measures.

### **Recommended Action:**

C. <u>25-228</u> Ordinance to Amend Chapters 1-2-1 of the Municipal Code, Fees (Tabled from November 17, 2025 meeting)

**Summary:** This ordinance updates the City's master fee schedule by increasing some fees, including short-term rental licenses, a new harbor sludge tipping fee that can be charged to the Army Corps of Engineers, and restructuring how building permit fees.
