5. NEW ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND ACTION

- A. TRFD Garden (offered by Chief Dave Murack) planning
 - 1. Trial for non-traditional/dwarf vegetable plant for FYVG 2024

Need volunteers to do these projects (preparation and maintenance of front yard vegetable gardens). If we cannot find any volunteers, put these projects on hold.

- Possibly check with Boy Scouts.
- Park & Rec summer camp program addition. Four days per week for six to eight weeks over summer.
- Possibly the fire department may be able to help with tilling, planting, weeding, watering and picking since is at their site.

Want to consider using dwarf varieties (special order seeds/plants) to keep the plants under three feet tall.

B. <u>Reward program for pervious surface installation</u>

* Street credit policy – reward for installing more pervious surfaces. (Look/revise existing credit policy?)

- * Charged for impervious surfaces stormwater fee/charge
- * Don Wouldn't a reduction of gray infrastructure to green reduce area which reduces the fee?
- * Darla would possibly like more.

C. EAB/Main Street's Senior Center vertical planting and mural project

See conceptual photo for west wall of senior center. Note that this is within the Business

Improvement District and has been discussed previously at the senior center. Main Street would like to donate resources towards it.

There are concerns about maintaining it. It would be at a high traffic (bus stop) with a lot of pedestrian traffic. Possibly look at indoor improvements for air quality. Should talk with the Friends of the Senior Center for approval of a/the mural.
