1. A Public Hearing for the Revised Proposed 2025 Millage Rate to Remain at 2.889 -
Brandon Perkins, Town Manager

Mr. Perkins shared that tonight was the last of three public hearings for the revised millage rate to remain at 2.889 mills for the seventeenth year in a row. The revised public hearings were due to a recalculation of the tax digest that was based on House Bill 581. The County and most cities must go through the same process again. The proposed millage rate was estimated to provide revenue for approximately 16% of the budgeted General Fund expenses. He added that if the millage stays at 2.889 mills, it should result in approximately \$38,585 more than last year which was a 1.92% increase.
