10. Reports of Officers

a. Fire Station Update

Tim Cowan the Public Works Director shared a PowerPoint Presentation following the bid openings for the subcontractors for the Fire Station construction. The estimated guaranteed maximum price (GMP) is \$13.7M and the estimated furnishings, fixtures, & equipment (FFE) is around \$400k. These values fall within the target value of < \$14.4M. Cowan reviewed the bid packages and shared anticipated minority and women's business enterprises and union utilization percentages. Cowan shared a tentative timeline and reviewed the next steps in the construction process. Questions and discussion ensued.
