4. Public Input and Presentations

a. Public Input

George encouraged the Urbana City Council to consider preventing fake women's healthcare clinics from being allowed in Urbana. **Arthur** echoed concerns about fake women's healthcare clinics. Shared that these crisis centers pose a public health threat.

CM Bishop shared information about the Economic Development department is hosting the Downtown Public Realm Study event on Wednesday. Bishop encouraged the public to exercise their right to vote. Mayor Marlin shared an update of the first responder's efforts to respond to the threats made to the Urbana Schools this morning. City offices will be closed on Friday in observance of Veterans Day.
