1. Call to Order and Roll Call

With a quorum present, Chair Quisenberry called the meeting of the Urbana City Council to order at 7:38 p.m.

4. Presentations and Public Input

a. Public Input

Gabriel spoke on the need for political tensions to be decreased and the need for polite political discussion. Hoped for antiviolence programs to promote civil debate and discussion.

6. New Business

- a. **Ordinance No. 2026-07-019:** An Ordinance Amending the Urbana Zoning Ordinance (Amend Article II and Article VIII of the Urbana Zoning Ordinance to Lower Minimum Parking Requirements for Commercial Workshops / Plan Case No. 2525-T-26) – CD

Presented by Evan Alvarez, Principal Planner. The Ordinance amends the Zoning Ordinance to reflect the requirements of Public Act 104-457, Illinois People Over Parking Act (POPA), which prohibits municipal governments from enforcing minimum parking requirements near transit corridors and hubs of transit activity. Evan Alvarez shared that POPA recently went into effect on June 1, 2026. Stated the change prohibits minimum automobile parking requirements if the project is within one-half mile of a “public transportation hub” or one-eighth mile of a “public transportation corridor”, unless it meets certain exceptions. Noted a significant number of areas in the City of Urbana are within close proximity to public transit. Clarified POPA does not apply to development projects intended for use as a hotel or any other transient lodging. Displayed a map illustrating the areas of Urbana impacted by POPA where minimum parking requirements cannot be enforced for new development projects.

Stated the part of the amendment adds POPA’s definitions of “public transportation corridor” and “public transportation hub” to the Urbana Zoning Ordinance. Stated the amendment adds a subpoint to the segment on parking requirements to clarify POPA and that voluntary parking spots must still comply with Zoning Ordinance regulations set by Urbana. Shared that the Ordinance advances the goals of Imagine Urbana to enact changes that promote walkability and brings Urbana into compliance with newly implemented State legislation. Questions and discussion followed.

- b. **Ordinance No. 2026-07-020:** An Ordinance Amending the Urbana Zoning Ordinance (Amend Article II and Article VIII of the Urbana Zoning Ordinance to Lower Minimum Parking Requirements for Commercial Workshops / Plan Case No. 2526-T-26) – CD

Presented by Evan Alvarez, Principal Planner. The Ordinance amends the Zoning Ordinance so that non-customer-facing commercial workshop spaces are appropriately defined and have appropriate development options for parking requirements. Evan Alvarez spoke on how the use category of a given development is determined by Community Development and then assigned its respective parking requirement from Table VIII-7 of the Zoning Ordinance. Noted the Zoning Administrator approximates the use designation for uncategorized uses. Spoke on how parking requirements can harm smaller businesses and how excessive parking requirements damage the environment. Stated the amendment renames “Contractor Shop and Showroom” to “Contractor Supply and Showroom; adds the “Commercial Workshop” use under Table VIII-7; and establishes definitions for “Building Material Sales”, “Contractor Supply and Showroom”, and “Commercial Workshop”. Discussion ensued.

- c. **Resolution No. 2026-07-024R:** A Resolution Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois Concerning Certified Housing Inspections (Term of 2026 to 2029) – CD

Presented by Olivia Jovine, Director of Community Development Services. The Resolution approves the renewal of the three-year intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with the University of Illinois, Board of Trustees, to allow for the City's Building Safety Division to conduct annual Private Certified Housing inspections with respect to all applicable City codes and University certified housing standards. Olivia Jovine, presented on behalf of the Building Safety Division, sharing background on the partnership with the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign's (UIUC) Certified Housing Program that had its most recent IGA approved in 2023 for inspections that have been conducted since the 1950s. Stated the IGA enables UIUC to compensate the City for building inspection services provided within the scope of the IGA. Questions followed.

Presented by Chris Kalter, Grants Division Manager alongside Resolutions No. 2026-07-026R, 2026-07-027R, 2026-07-028R, 2026-07-029R, 2026-07-030R, 2026-07-031R, 2026-07-032R, 2026-07-033R, 2026-07-034R, 2026-07-035R, 2026-07-036R, 2026-07-037R, 2026-07-038R, 2026-07-039R, 2026-07-040R, 2026-07-041R, and 2026-07-042R. The Resolution approves and authorizes the execution of a subrecipient agreement as part of the City's Community Services Grant Program with the Urbana-Champaign Independent Media Center (UCIMC) to provide \$25,000 in funding toward their UCIMC Summer for Youth project. Chris Kalter stated the Community Services Grant (CSG) supports private, not-for-profit agencies and public entities that provide community-based services and resources for low-income households in Urbana. Noted \$628,131.14 in funding was available through the CSG for the year of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. Spoke on the application process for the CSG (originally open from February 2, 2026, to April 6, 2026) with pre-application workshops available during February and March.

Shared applications for 45 programs across 38 organizations were received, requesting a total of \$2,672,735.20 in funding. Stated the CSG Application Review Committee evaluated the applications through a rubric, their background, their experience, and by group discussion. Noted the policies established do not guarantee acceptance of an application solely based on the results of the rubric. Reported the Committee recommended funding the 18 programs across 15 organizations presented today using the entirety of the CSG funds available. Displayed tables detailing the programs, organizations, and recommended funding amounts for the 18 programs. Questions and discussion followed.

8. Council Input and Communications

CM Wu expressed appreciation for student engagement in City developments, Boards, and Commissions. Stated students face the issue of being unable to afford housing, not being unable to find housing. Stated new housing developments contribute to the unavailability of affordable housing. **CM Jones** wished everyone a good holiday weekend. Shared appreciation for Mayor Williams' public leadership and welcomed CM Cockrell. **CM Hursey** welcomed CM Cockrell to City Council. Expressed that the City has the opportunity to negotiate conditions with the developer regarding the Planned Unit Development considered in Ordinance No. 2026-05-013. Emphasized the need for additional housing in Urbana to accommodate growth and house workers.

8. Council Input and Communications (Continued)

Chair Quisenberry passed the Chair to CM Wu. CM Quisenberry welcomed CM Cockrell and thanked her for serving on City Council. Additionally, thanked Mayor Williams for the invitation to tour buildings under renovation on Silver Street and shared appreciation for the work conducted by the developer. ***Chair Wu relinquished the Chair to CM Quisenberry. CM Evans*** welcomed CM Cockrell to City Council. Requested Mayor Williams to share information on the renovation efforts shared by CM Quisenberry. ***Mayor Williams*** welcomed CM Cockrell to City Council. Shared Silver Street LLC is renovating 96 units across six buildings on Silver Street and will be publishing more information in the coming weeks. Stated the company will be in talks with the City, Cunningham Township, and community organizations to house people in need of affordable housing. Shared the company is composed of people from across the City of Peoria and the City of Indianapolis in the State of Indiana and intends to hire local property managers. ***CM Cockrell*** voiced appreciation for the welcome from City Council. Acknowledged the care the community has for the character of their neighborhoods. Stated the housing crisis in Urbana requires an increase in all forms of housing and denying new housing developments does not help in addressing the crisis, strengthening the entire Urbana community, and allowing more people to live in Urbana.
