a. Resolution No. 2023-09-079R: A Resolution Authorizing Acceptance of an Illinois Arts Council Agency (IACA) Grant for Public Arts Program Operating Support – CD

a. Ordinance No. 2023-09-032: An Ordinance Revising the Annual Budget Ordinance (Budget Amendment #1 - Omnibus) - HRF

Presented by CM Quisenberry. Item amends the annual budget ordinance to account for purchases and projects not yet completed in the previous FY that still need to be budgeted for. The new estimated ending fund balance in the General Operating Fund would be \$18,900,929, which is 46.53% of recurring expenditures. Excluding the \$7M assigned for future transfers for capital improvements, including Equity and Quality of Life (EQoL) projects, the fund balance would be \$11,900,929 which is 29.30% of recurring expenditures.

Motion to earmark the \$1.5 million in DCEO funds to be allocated for future Capital Improvement Projects to be returned before Council for approval prior to being spent by CM Wilken and seconded by CM Evans. *Motion withdrawn*.

Motion to amend the ordinance to strike the two items concerning the DCEO grant from exhibit A to allow for further discussion by CM Quisenberry and seconded by CM Wilken.

b. Resolution No. 2023-09-080R: A Resolution Expressing Official Intent Regarding Certain Capital Expenditures to be Reimbursed from or Paid with Proceeds of an Obligation to be Issued by the City of Urbana, Illinois - HRF

Presented by CM Quisenberry. Item declares the City's intent to reimburse itself with bond proceeds for expenditures related to design and construction of two new fire stations and other projects, but does not create any obligation to issue debt. This is necessary to satisfy Internal Revenue Service (IRS) requirements regarding the tax-exempt status of bonds to be issued in the future.
