- Collaborated with a diverse collection of local artists and organizations
- Presented performances at an accessible time and space.
 - Every Saturday, May through October, the program featured programming from noon – 5pm
 - when weather permitted, all events took place outdoors.
- Presented a majority of performances free of charge for attendance
- Activated downtown Urbana daytime on Saturdays

- Every Saturday: May through October
- Diverse array of entertainment, events & collaborations
- noon 5pm every week!
 - Accessible to anyone with any scheduling conflicts
 - All ages
 - No cover charge for all events
 - Primarily outside so accommodating immunocompromised,
 and those adverse to the music venue and bar scene
- At least 2 different collaborators every Saturday
 - This was essential for providing diversity of experience, community outreach, and exposure and interest while having something for everyone
 - Primarily featured local (Champaign county and adjacent) artists and organizations, but, also some touring acts








SCOPE OF SUMMER PROGRAM:






