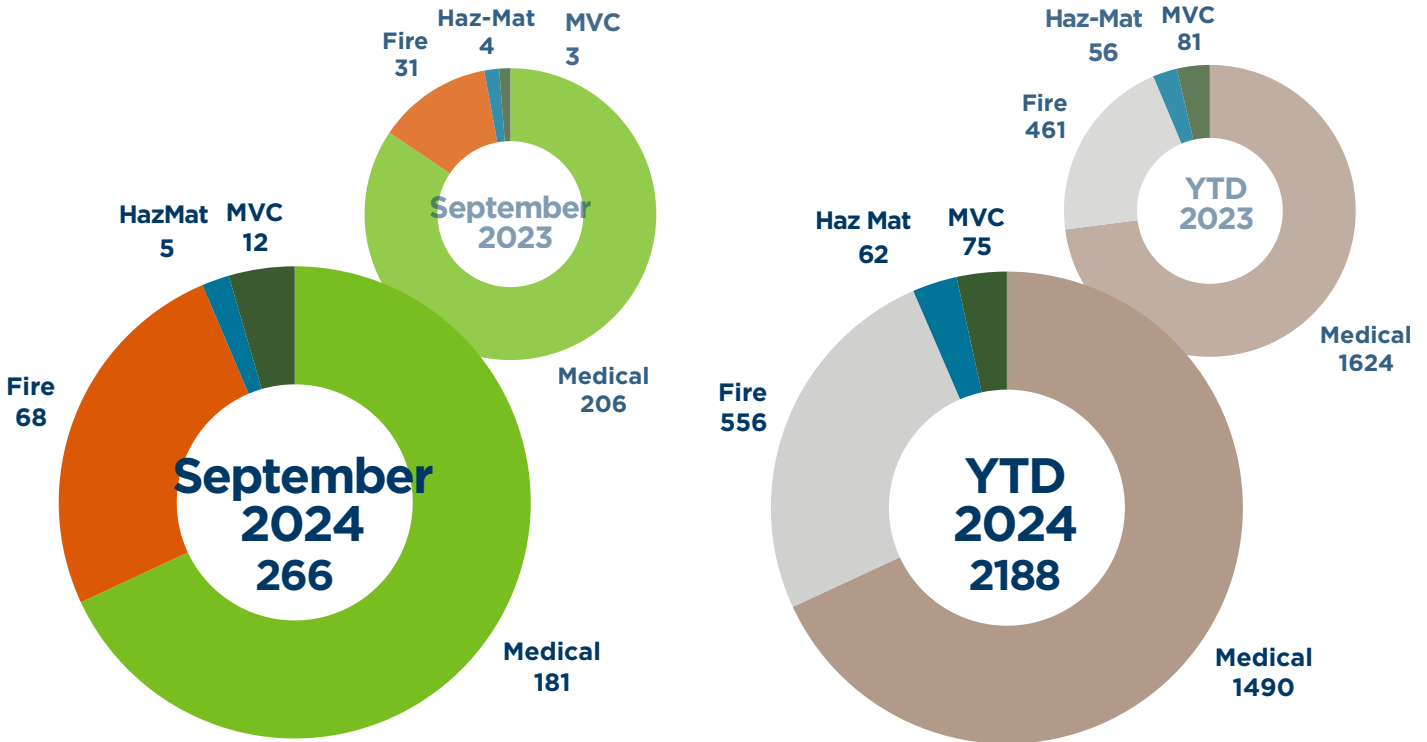

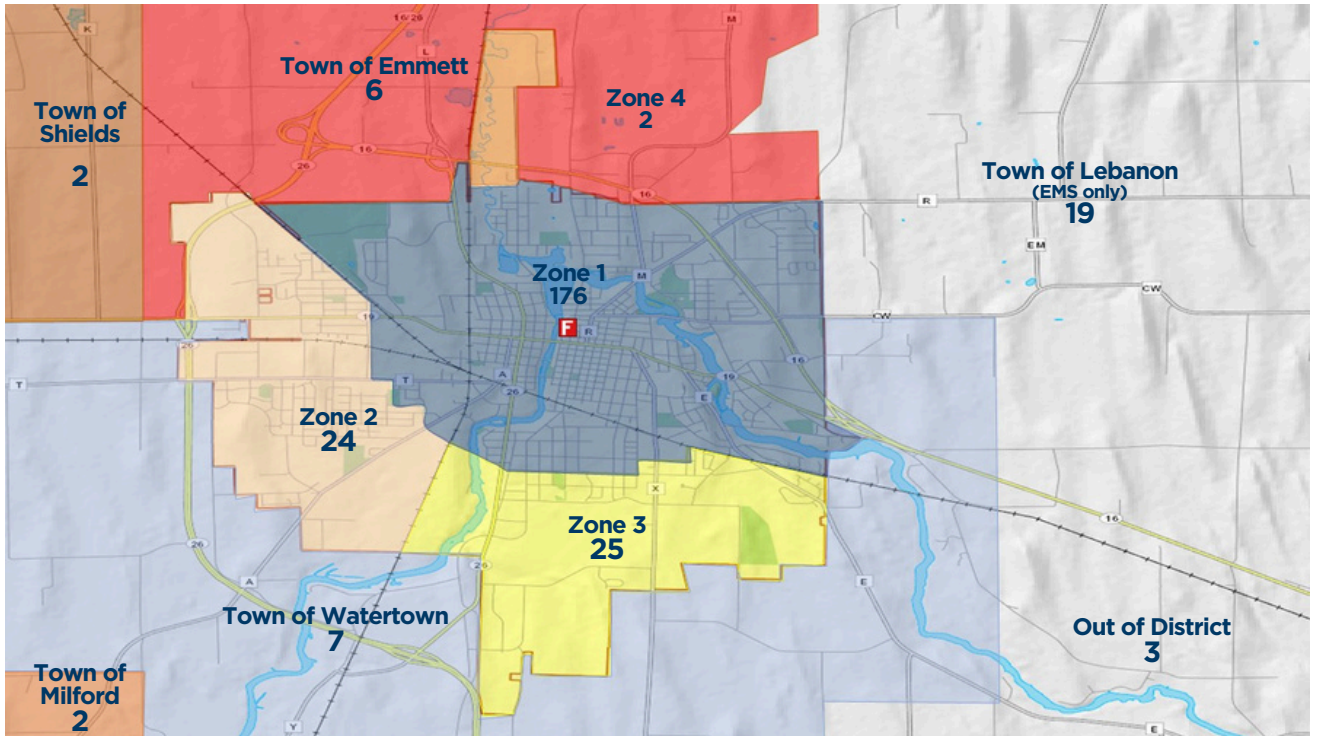


## Calls by Type

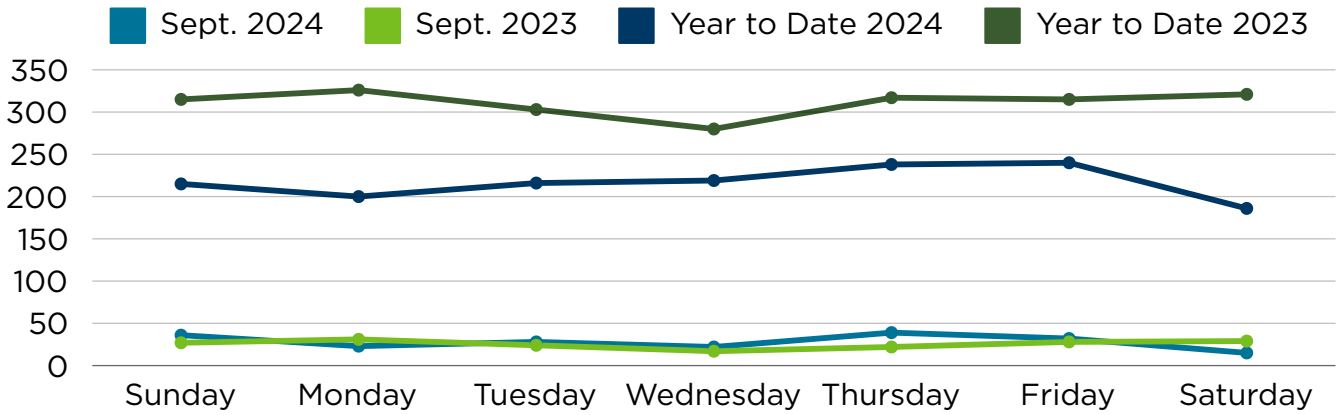

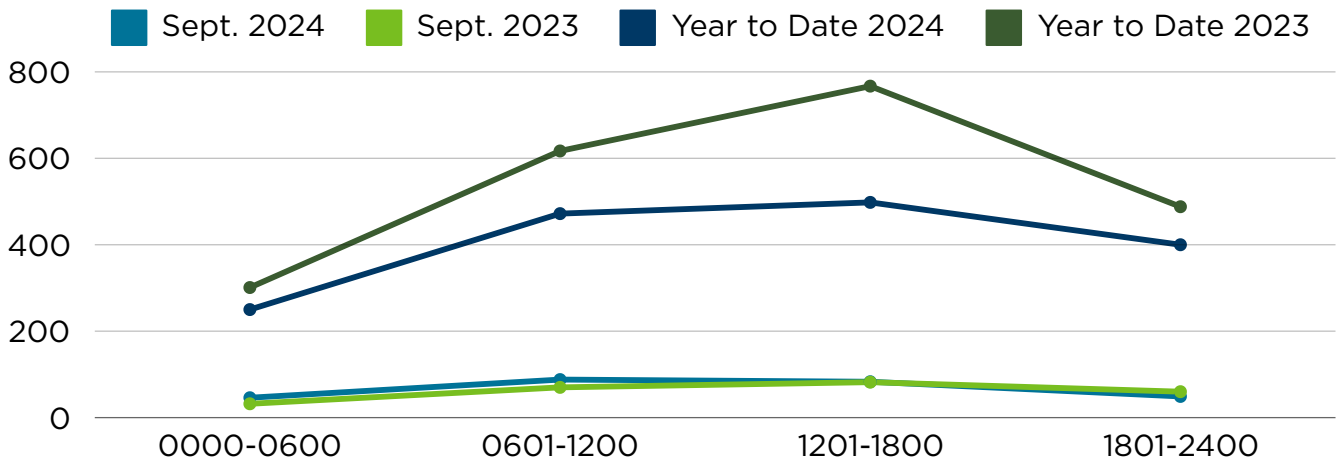
## Calls per Zone September

## Calls by Time of Day

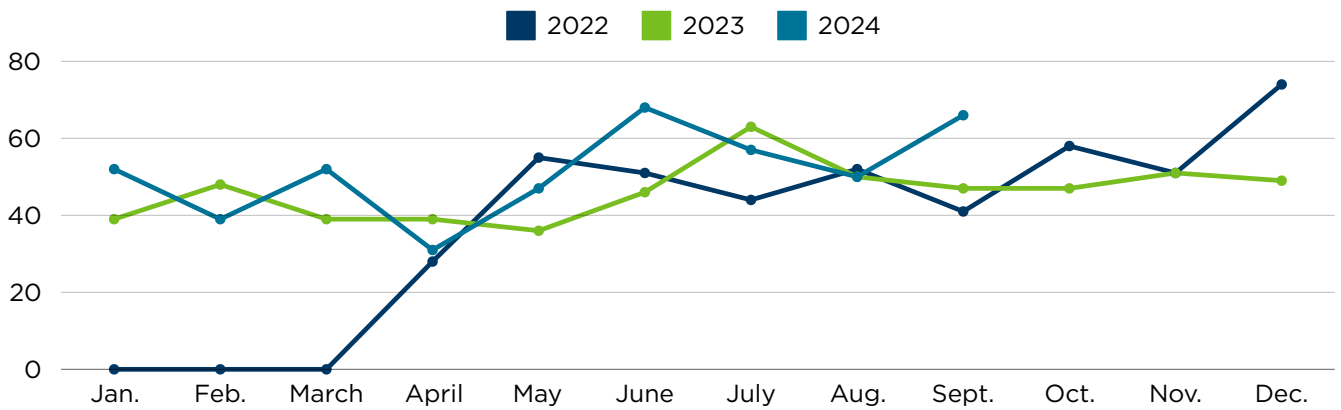

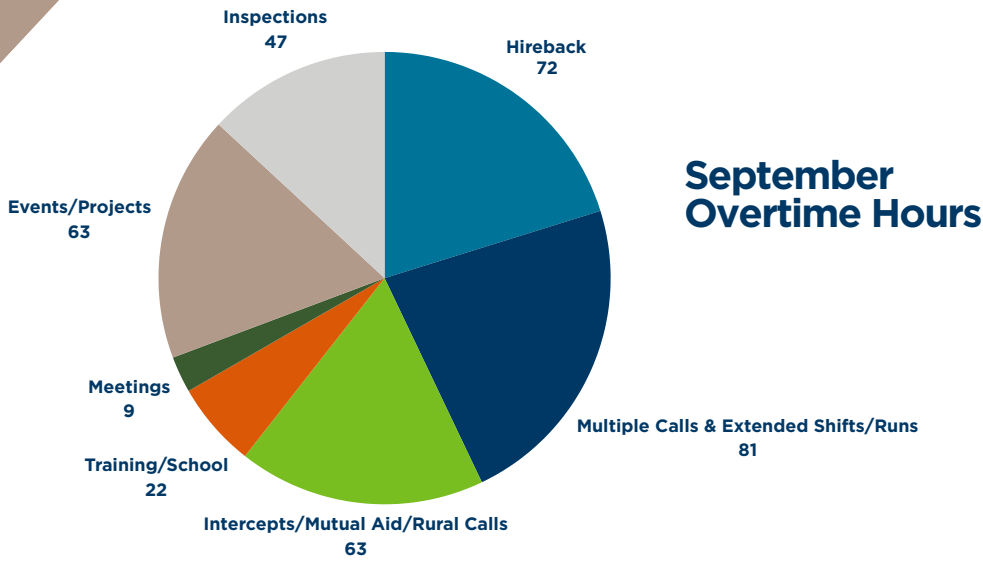

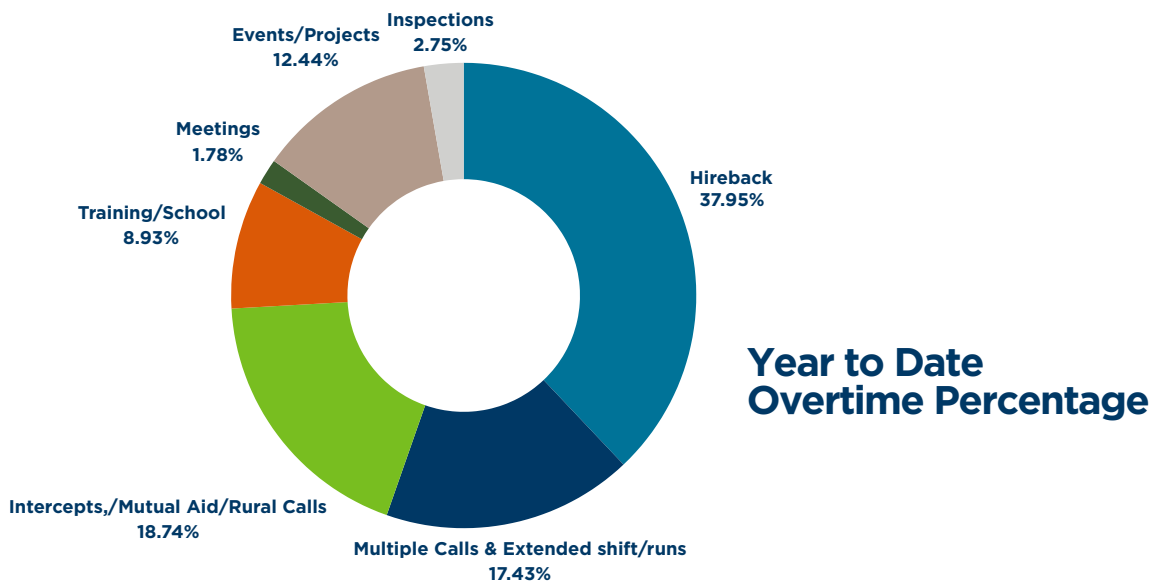
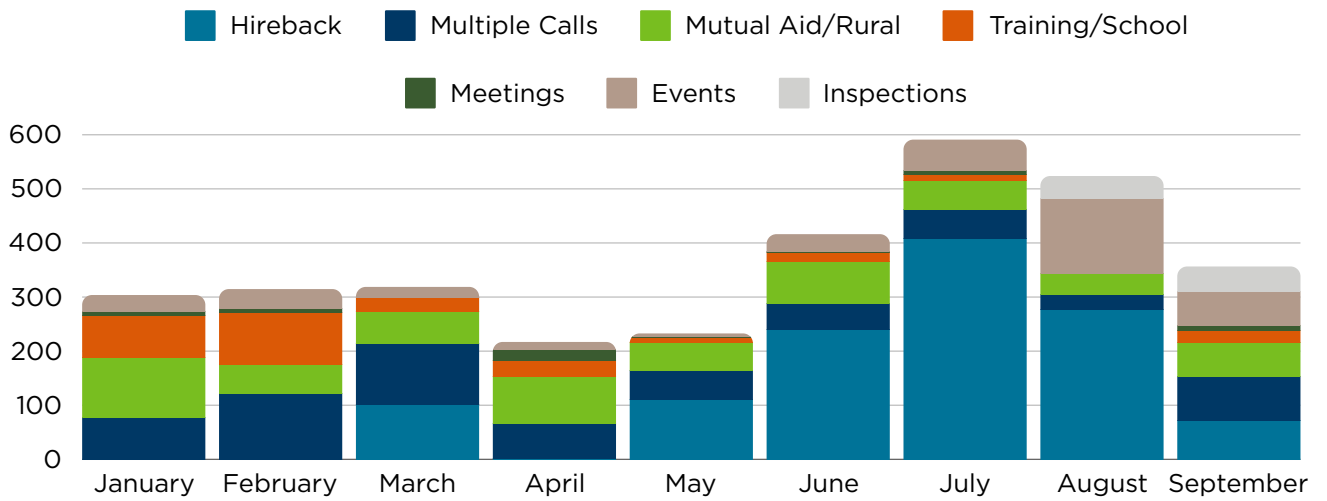


## Off Duty Call Backs & Responses



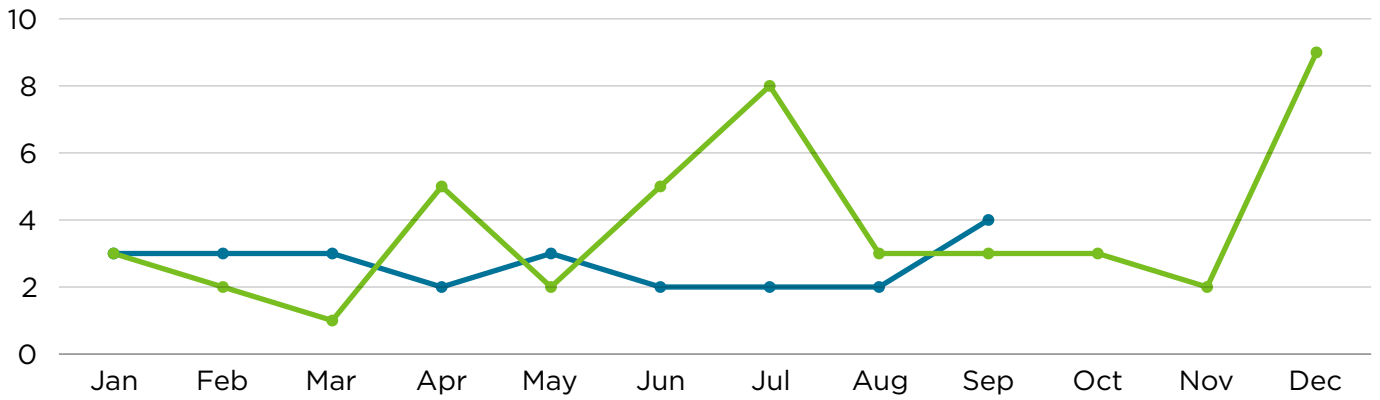


### Total Monthly Overtime Hours

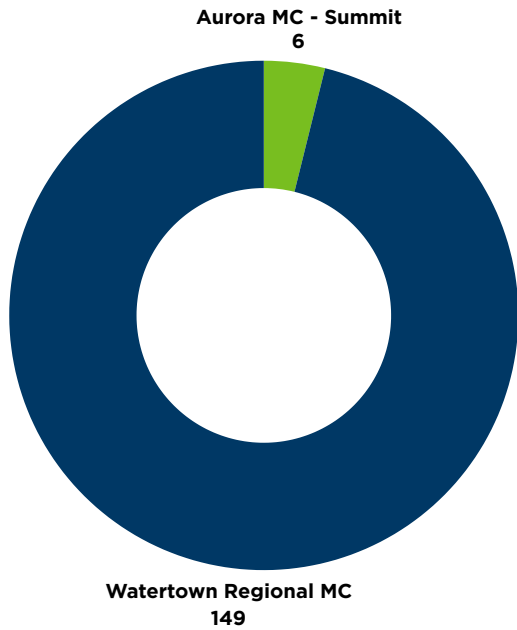




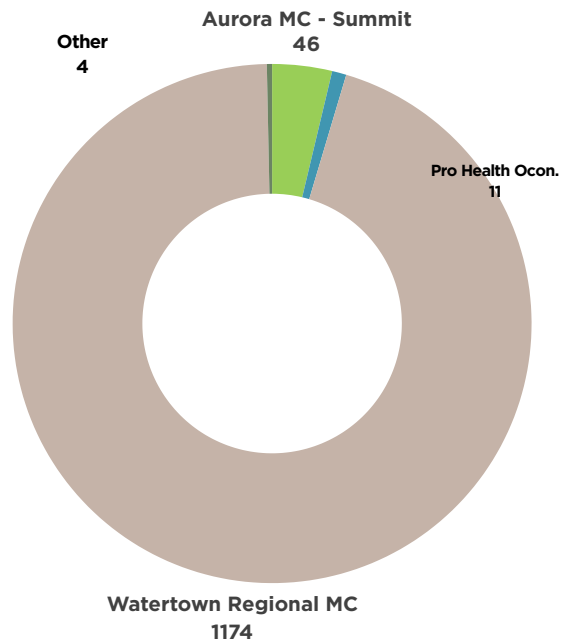
## Overdoses 2024 | 2023

## Hospital Transports Year to Date





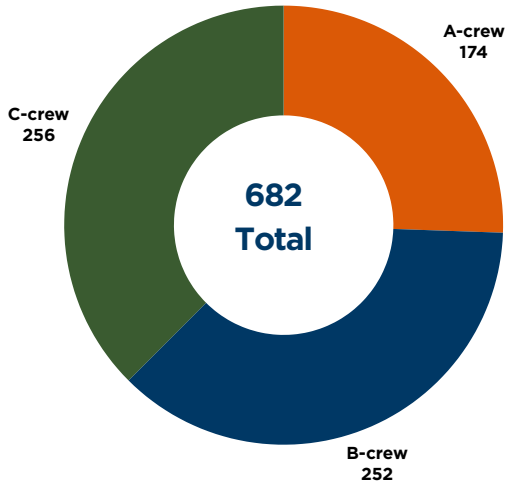

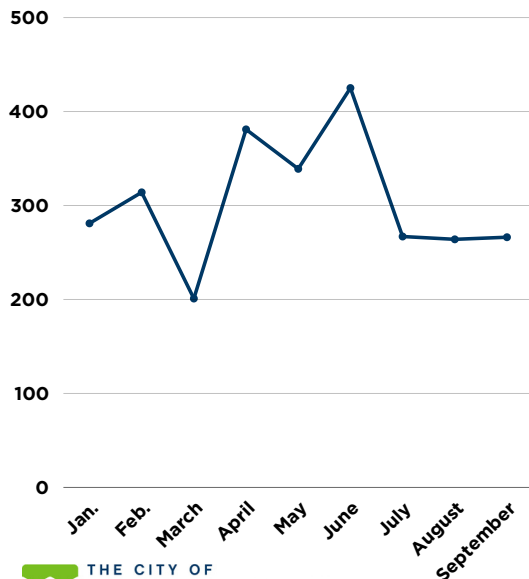

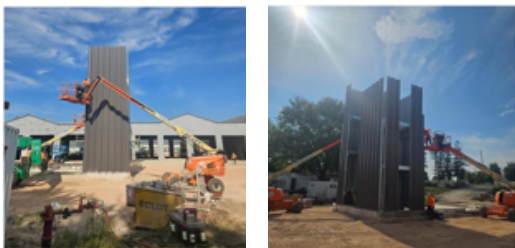


The crew attended the 9/11 ceremony at Aero Park.
